NOTICE AND ORDER OF ONLINE MEETING – JANUARY 24, 2022

WHEREAS, the State of Utah is in its twenty-second month of documented cases of the COVID-19 global pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 variant known as “omicron” has been documented as being more highly-transmittable and faster-spreading than the preceding variants of the virus; and

WHEREAS, while arguably less-severe than prior strains, the extensiveness of the transmission of the omicron variant continues to place an excessive strain on our local health care system; and

WHEREAS, the omicron variant has rapidly increased infection rates among students and staff throughout Davis School District over the past several weeks, to the point that the majority of the high schools and junior high schools in the district have announce their transition to temporary remote learning since January 17, 2022 after reaching their “Test to Stay threshold” numbers but seeing “Test to Stay” suspended statewide last week by state leaders due to a lack of testing kits and/or manpower; and

WHEREAS, Central Davis Junior High (“CDJH”) announced January 19, 2022 that its threshold number had been reached, that it would transition to remote learning beginning January 20, 2022, and remaining in remote learning status through January 24, 2022; and

WHEREAS, we seek to limit the exposure of the community – and especially our students and staff – to the effects of the ongoing pandemic so that our students can experience the benefits from being physically present in school as much as possible under the present circumstances; and

WHEREAS, the regularly-scheduled Central Davis Community Council (“CDCC”) meeting falls within the remote learning timeframe which is meant to give the Central Davis community a chance to “reset” and try to get its infection rate back down below the threshold number, and

WHEREAS, based on the foregoing, the CDCC chair and the CDJH principal find that there exists a substantial risk to the health and safety of those who would otherwise be physically present at the regularly-scheduled January 24, 2022 CDCC meeting, and said risk can easily be mitigated by moving the meeting online without unduly affecting either the members’ or the public’s ability to attend and appropriately participate,

THEREFORE, consistent with Utah Code Ann. Sec. 52-4-101 et seq. and Sec. 5 of the CDCC Bylaws, the meeting of the Central Davis Community Council currently scheduled for Monday, January 24, 2022 at 4:30 p.m. will be held virtually via Zoom.
