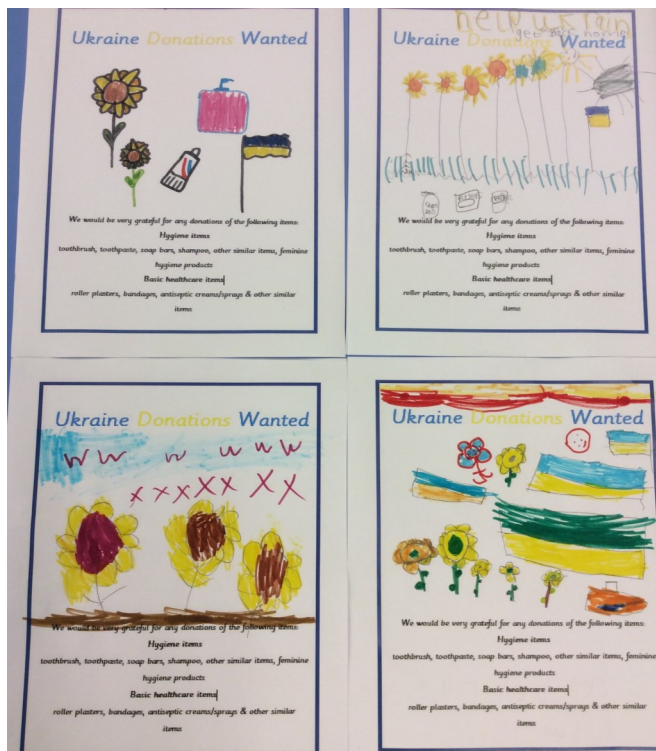


Donations wanted for Ukraine Appeal

One of our kind Year 5 pupils will also be on the playground selling sunflower seeds (the national flower of Ukraine) next week so please look out for her.

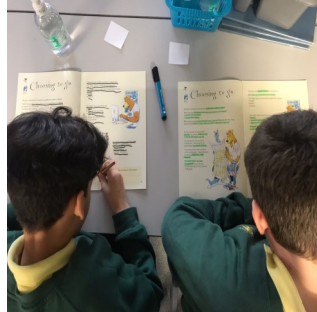
