





#### WHAT SUPPLIES WILL MY CHILD NEED & HAVE AT HOME?

- CHROMEBOOKS (PICK UP DATE MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 14TH 1:30 BMS)
- Headphones to help with background noise, especially if there are multiple learners at home
- Prek Learning Bags & Individual Classroom Bins
- K-2 Learning Binders
- MATERIALS FOR SPECIALIST (ART, PE, Music, Etc.)
- Have items available if you child might need fidgets or tools to help them concentrate while working. These are not toys!



# MAKE A SCHEDULE THAT WORKS FOR YOUR FAMILY

- Use visuals to serve as reminders
- If your child needs to have one step directions, break up the schedule into small details.
- EVEN THOUGH STUDENTS ARE HOME, SET UP THEIR MORNING ROUTINES
  BEFORE THEY 'GO TO SCHOOL' THIS WILL HELP WHEN WE RETURN TO HYBRID
  TOO!
- CREATE AS MUCH OF A ROUTINE AS YOU CAN! THAT IS WHY WE ARE
   CREATING THE DAILY SCHEDULES FOR YOUR STUDENTS. KIDS LOOK FOR
   THAT STRUCTURE AND BALANCE.


- WE ABSOLUTELY KNOW THE DISTANCE LEARNING

#### SPECIAL EDUCATION

- SPECIAL EDUCATION STAFF WILL CREATE INDIVIDUAL SERVICE PLANS FOR STUDENTS TO REFLECT LEARNING IN THE REMOTE AND HYBRID MODELS
- RELATED SERVICE PROVIDERS (SPEECH/LANGUAGE, OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY, PHYSICAL THERAPY) ARE BUILDING BASED
