

Austin Preparatory School French Teacher

French Teachers report directly to the Assistant Head/Head of the Upper School, Head of the Middle School and Foreign Language Department Chair. French Teachers must be fluent in French and have at least 3 years of classroom instruction experience. Faculty teach five sections of students on a seven-day rotating schedule of four classes per day. Over the course of a seven-day academic cycle, a teacher will plan and deliver 20 seventy-five minute classes. Teachers are responsible to deliver school and academic department approved curriculum on behalf of the School in support of the School's mission.

The World Languages Department is also seeking a Department Chair to begin the 2022-2023 Academic Year. In conjunction with teaching, Chairs are responsible for facilitating the operation of the department, which includes hiring and management of staff, assessing and selecting instructional materials, designing, and revising curriculum as needed, assisting teachers in improving instruction, and coordinating the overall instructional efforts of the World Languages Department. The Department Chair embodies professionalism and strong leadership qualities necessary for a successful departmental operation on behalf of the School in support of the School's mission. The Chair would have a reduced instructional schedule, teaching up to four (4) sections.
