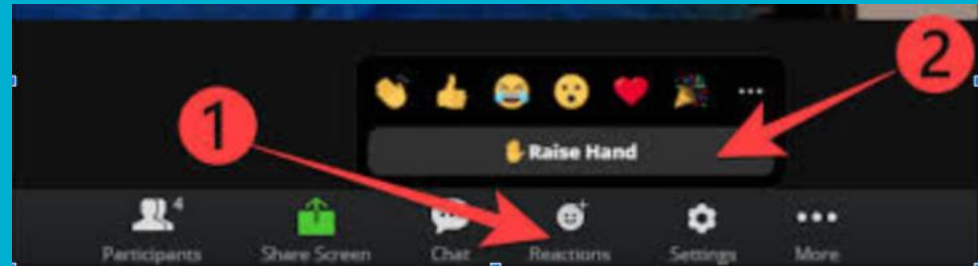
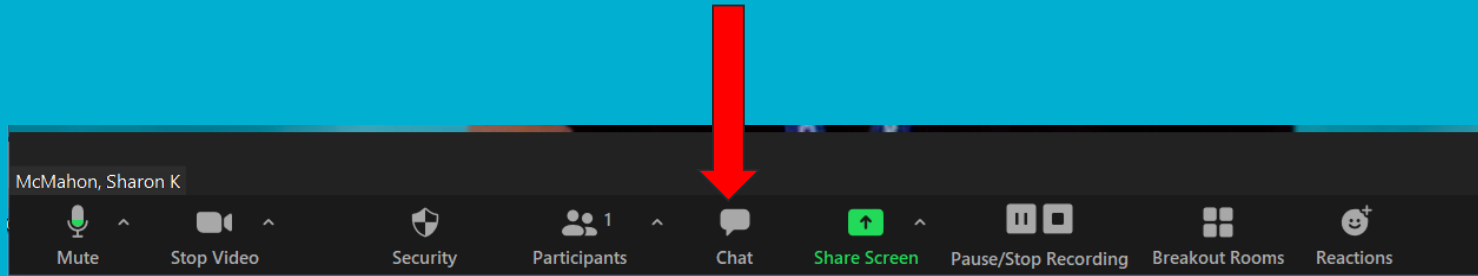

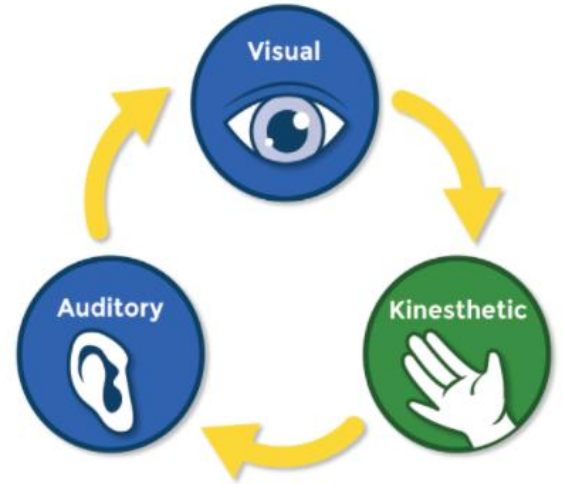
Different Learning Styles

Auditory- When you study, try saying information aloud to yourself or someone else. Look for the speaker icon on websites, where it will read the information to you.

Visual- Draw pictures and/or diagrams as you study to help visualize the information. Read over notes and text.

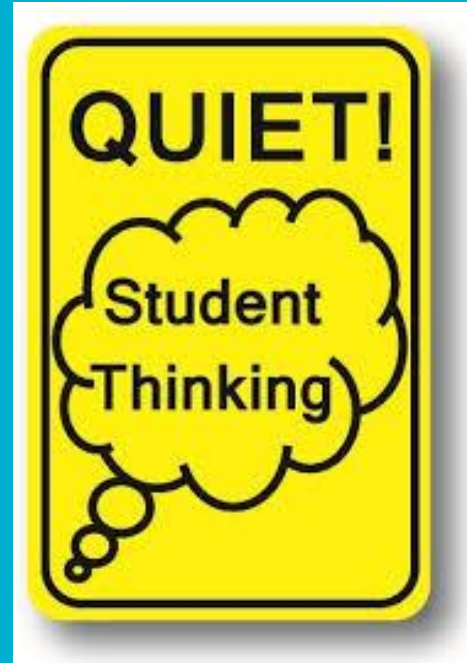
Kinesthetic- Get up and moving while studying, bounce a ball as you say the information to yourself. Rewrite notes to involve physical motion.

Three Main Pathways to the Brain



Have a Designated Study/Homework Space

- Place to charge technology
- Free of distractions
- Supplies easily accessible

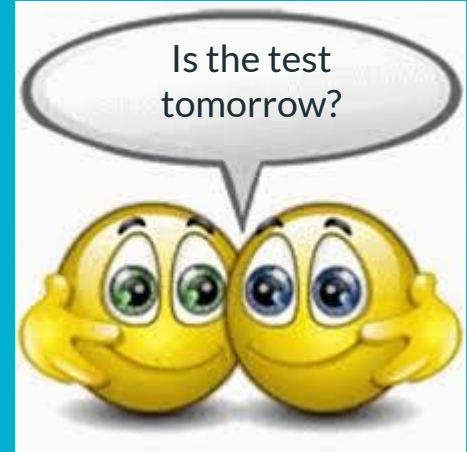


Study Partner

-Encourage your child to connect to at least one other student in each class.

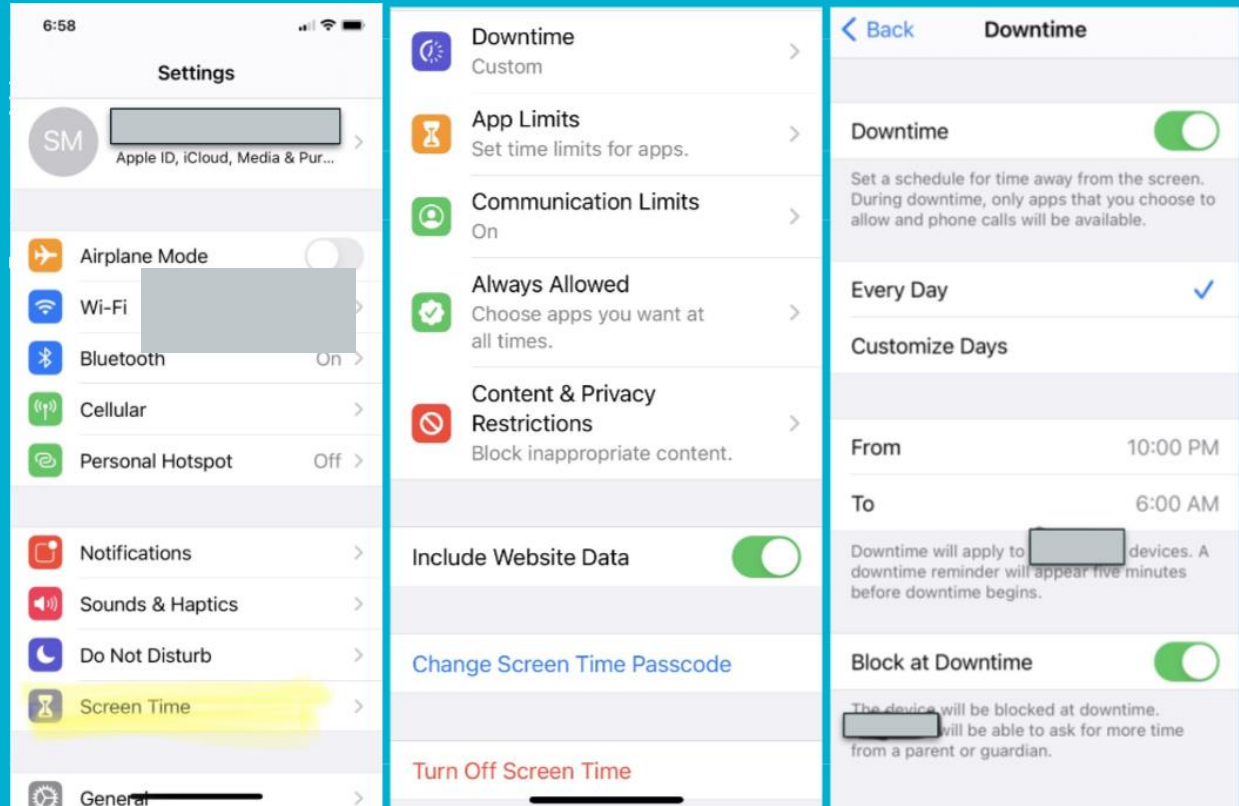
-Use this student as a study partner.

-Person to be able to text/call if they forget what assignment is due, miss class, have a question, etc.



Limiting Personal Technology “Screen Time”
