Keeping You Informed Regarding COVID-19 Response Measures - June 05, 2020

Dear Valued Clients and Partners:

As your partners in health, RxBenefits wants to keep you aware of all news related to the coronavirus (COVID-19).

Local and state governments are starting to focus on reopening the economy and are loosening restrictions on gathering, which means members will now have greater access to medical services and local pharmacies. As this continues, some of the exceptions implemented due to the pandemic will not be needed.

Starting in mid-June, we will end the early refill limits on 30-day maintenance medication prescriptions. After the date listed below, claims for maintenance medications will process with standard refill thresholds, and the non-emergency refill threshold limits will again apply.

- **CVS Caremark®** ([click here for details](#))
 - Effective **June 15, 2020**, CVS Caremark will no longer waive early refill limits on 30-day prescriptions for maintenance medications. CVS Health pharmacies will continue to offer home delivery of maintenance medications to support social distancing standards.
- **Express Scripts** ([click here for details](#))
 - Effective **June 19, 2020**, Express Scripts (ESI) will no longer waive early refill limits on 30-day prescriptions for maintenance medications.
- **OptumRx** ([click here for details](#))
 - Effective **June 30, 2020**, OptumRx will no longer waive early refill limits on 30-day prescriptions for maintenance medications.
