

\$6.4 Million in savings over 20 years










Phase III- "Main Street and Conversion of Former Middle School

Transform Middle School into Labs, Learning Centers, and Elementary Classrooms






Middle School Plan





















Middle School Plan Renovation of Classrooms & Hallways




