



Campus Master Planning Committee (Ad Hoc)
Charge
January 2022

The charge of the ad hoc Campus Master Planning Committee is to support the development of a campus master plan. The master plan will represent a utilization of space that meets the long-term needs of Haldane's students and staff.

The committee will consist of:

- Haldane Board of Education representative
- Superintendent of Schools
- Director of Facilities
- Building Administrator
- Teachers (3 - one from each level)
- Staff members (2)
- Parent Representatives (3)
- Liaison to the Garrison school community
- Representatives from Town and Village government, to the extent practicable
- Representative from local emergency services
- Representative from the Philipstown Recreation Department
- Representative from the Chamber of Commerce
- Trade professionals, particularly those who may have previous experience with public service projects
- An individual with background experience in creative long-term use, including facilities planning

The ad hoc campus master planning committee will:

- (1) Liaise between the consultant and community groups to provide feedback through the master plan design process.
- (2) Provide feedback to the administration prior to final recommendations being made to the Board of Education.
- (3) Provide feedback to the administration on the conceptualization and scope of future capital projects.
