

THE CARL BORNFRIEND/FRISCO NATIVE AMERICAN MUSEUM SCHOLARSHIP

The CARL BORNFRIEND/FRISCO NATIVE AMERICAN MUSEUM SCHOLARSHIP is hereby established at Cape Hatteras Secondary School of Coastal Studies in loving memory of Carl Bornfriend, founder and Executive Director of the museum. Mr. Bornfriend (1931-2019) was a lifelong educator and mentor, serving in the Dare County Schools and at College of the Albemarle from 1984 until his retirement in 1996. His teaching continued through the museum, making a profound impact upon thousands of visitors from near and far. Mr. Bornfriend was always a champion of underserved students based upon language, cultural or minority status. He was one of the founders of the English as a Second Language (ESL) program in Dare County.

The Scholarship shall be administered by, and the recipient shall be chosen by the CHSSCS Faculty Scholarship Committee, based upon the guidelines in this document.

The Scholarship will be awarded yearly to a graduating senior at Cape Hatteras Secondary School. The minimum amount of this award is \$1000.00, presented either to the recipient after the first semester in college, or to be sent directly to the college or university after the first semester.

The Scholarship shall be awarded to a deserving senior who meets any of the following criterion:

- *Has participated in an ESL program or identified as an English Language Learner (ELL) at *any time* during the student's academic career
- *Lives in a household where English is not the predominate language for a parent, guardian or family member.
- *Has experienced challenges with English proficiency or cultural or racial bias

The Scholarship Committee shall determine the method by which application is made for the award. It shall be at the discretion of the Committee whether an interview or other requirement shall be expected. No application, interview, essay or other requirement is expected by the Scholarship.

If the recipient is eighteen years old, he or she must be registered to vote in order to be eligible for consideration for the Scholarship. If not yet eighteen, this requirement shall be nullified. If not eligible to register to vote due to citizenship status, this requirement shall be nullified. Citizenship status SHALL NOT be considered by the Committee.

The presentation of the Scholarship shall be made at the annual Scholarship Awards Assembly.
