The William Floyd Counseling Center hosted three in person On-Site Admissions days for the 2021-2022 school year. The admissions representatives who participated were informative and excited to meet our students to discuss their post-secondary futures.

- * Use the NCAA Eligibility Center Code "9999" when you register to take the SAT or ACT. This allows your scores to be sent directly to the NCAA Eligibility Center.
- * Update your sports participation information regularly!

This year, the senior class is sponsoring a candy fundraiser.


