



Program Eligibility and Overview



Program Eligibility

- Must be a current high school junior (grade 11) in Renton
- Must be interested in fast tracking with a Career Launch program that includes worksite learning in internships and earning a college certificate
- Must be interested in entering the workforce upon completion of the 2-Year program





Full Program Overview: Required Steps of 2-year Program

Step 1 Complete a paid internship at Providence Marianwood during the summer between their junior and senior year of high school.

<u>Step 2</u> Complete one of the CNA program options during their senior year within the CNA certificate program at Renton Technical College.

<u>Step 3</u> Complete a second paid internship at Providence Marianwood during the summer after graduating from high school.

Step 4 Complete remaining coursework required to enter a WA State RN degree program during the year following high school graduation. During this time, there will be an option to start working as a CNA as soon as you turn 18.

<u>Step 5</u>

With successful completion of the course work and satisfactory employment with Providence, you will then apply to enter a Registered Nursing associate degree program as a highly competitive candidate and continue up the career ladder.

Work with your counselors to submit your application through Taleo

For new and returning students, you must respond "Yes" to screening question regarding your participation in the Renton School District Program to be considered for the program. If you say "no", your application will not be processed. Valerie Andal will conduct your interview on site at Providence Marianwood or online based on applicant's preference and availability.

Students will participate in an orientation and start their 6-week worksite experience.



 - Your work and/or volunteer experience
 - Relevant classes you have taken
 - Honors and awards you have received
- Submitting with your application is preferred but you may also wait and submit a resume once you have been chosen.
- Upload in PDF file format



Identifying Counselor Or Teacher For Letter Of Recommendation

You will be required to have a teacher or counselor submit a Letter of Recommendation which speaks to your qualifications and character as a potential candidate for this program.

In your application, you will provide the name and email address of the teacher or counselor who be submitting this letter as a reference on your behalf.

Upon completion of your application, the teacher or counselor identified will be contacted by email with information on how and where to submit their letter. Their letter of recommendation will be sent directly to Providence Marianwood and not to you.

Important: Discuss with the person you wish to write your letter before submitting their name as part of your application.
