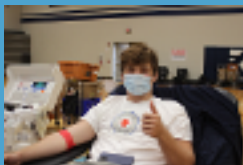

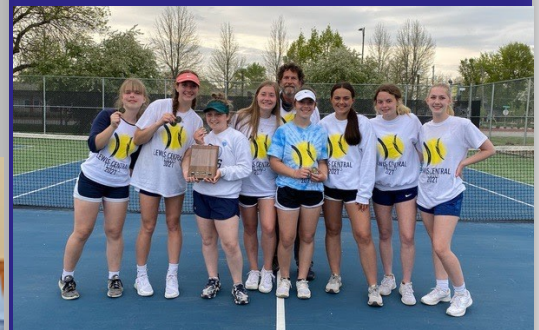

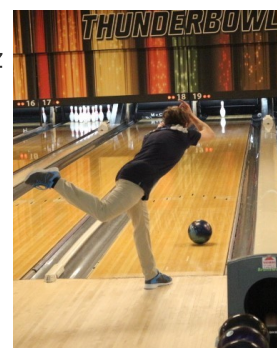
76% of graduating seniors earned 3 or more college credits from IWCC!

Excellence in the Classroom

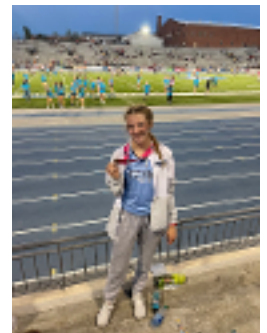

We made great gains, as teachers took risks with new curriculum, technology, and new strategies. While the nuances of the pandemic were tough, coaches and teachers did find some positives. We believe the way in which we collaborate and communicate will forever be changed. Utilizing Zoom, Google Classroom and Google docs opened up more opportunities to collaborate. The use of sites and other online platforms vastly increased the timeliness and quantity of our connections with students and parents. Knowing that students may be slightly behind in their learning due to quarantining kept us grounded in our use of data to meet students where they are in their learning.
