Academic Excellence of The Class of 2016

- ▶ **70% of graduating Seniors took the ACT**
- ▶ The number of **Seniors scoring 25+ increased by 47%** from 2015
- ▶ Seniors were awarded **\$6.7 million in scholarships**, up from \$1.8 million in 2012





