Admissions Timeline

BEGIN ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS

Apply online starting early December.

SHADOW DAYS

All students who are applying for admission to CHS are required to shadow for a day. Shadow days have proven to be beneficial to incoming students and are a great way to meet students, teachers, and experience student life first-hand.

ADMISSIONS INTERVIEW

At the end of the shadow day, families will have an admissions interview.

Qualifications: Student should be entering grades 6–12. Student should be in good academic standing and have a clean discipline record.

In order to apply for a scholarship, interested applicants must first complete the Catholic High admissions process. Financial need is a consideration but not a requirement.

ACE SCHOLARSHIP

ACE Scholarships is a nonprofit organization that raises money from generous donors and then awards financial scholarships to students from low-income families so they can attend the school of their choice. WORK STUDY PROGRAM

Students that are in need of financial assistance can apply for aid through our Work Study program. This program allows families to work hours on our campus in the summer months in return for tuition credits.

ARETE SCHOLARSHIP

Arete scholarship amounts are reset each year and cannot exceed the lesser of either the school's tuition or mandatory fees. Applications for the following school year will open at the end of February and remain open through the month of March.




