Dear WPSD Stakeholder:

The William Penn School District Strategic Plan – *Focus Forward 2025* includes a review of our facilities. The Board of School Directors authorized KCBA Architects to develop a comprehensive Facilities Master Plan that would become an output from our Strategic Plan. KCBA's review revealed suggested upgrades/improvements to our facilities.

I'm pleased to report the School Board approved an improvement project that is a ten-year plan through which all WPSD schools will receive upgrades. Recommendations also include a future grade configuration of grades K-5, 6-8 and 9-12. This plan will have the ability to, over time, reduce overcrowding in our schools and offer 21st-century facilities for the students we serve. The district is exploring grant money and partnership, as well as advocating for federal funding. However, we will need community support and commitment to fund this initiative.

Enclosed is a one-page information sheet about the 10-Year Facilities Improvement Plan. We hope you will be in support of this plan to provide these important upgrades to our facilities and a better academic environment for students.
