

The Pontiac School District has partnered with Covenant Academy to provide students with a unique learning opportunity. The Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) program provides students with the entry-level knowledge and clinical skills necessary to enter the healthcare field to work as a Certified Nursing Assistant in hospitals, sub-acute, rehabilitation care settings, urgent care and travel CNA.

As a vital member of the healthcare team, CNAs provide direct patient care such as, but not limited to taking vital signs, specimen collection and comfort measures.

This program provides excellent preparation for entry into any nursing program. Additionally, on average CNA/ PCTs earn a salary of \$43,000-51,000 annually. Students must complete 75 combined hours of coursework and clinical experience to successfully fulfill the CNA program.

Students who have completed this program have been accepted to collegiate nursing programs.
