COLLEGE, HIGH SCHOOL: WHAT HAPPENS IF A STUDENT IS IN CONTACT* WITH A STUDENT SICK WITH COVID-19?

Continuation of face-to-face learning and completion of a self-test on D+2**. Wearing a mask indoors is strongly recommended for contact cases for 7 days after the occurrence of the confirmed case.

If the self-test*** is negative

- **No isolation**
Continuation of face-to-face courses

If the self-test*** is positive

- **Student becomes a confirmed case**
• **Isolation for 7 days which can be reduced to 5 days** if an antigen or PCR test carried out on the 5th day is negative and in the absence of symptoms for 48 hours

Students infected with Covid-19 less than 2 months ago can continue face-to-face lessons without taking a test, unless symptoms appear.

If a new case appears within less than 7 days, it is not necessary to carry out a new screening.

The legal representatives are given the self-test free of charge at the pharmacy upon presentation of the letter provided by the school.

* Student having shared a class with the confirmed case (common core class, specialty groups, options, languages, etc.), without distinction between students having or not wearing the mask, or other close contact with a confirmed case without the one of the two people is not wearing a mask.

** 2 days after the last contact with the confirmed case or the day of the information if the contact took place for more than 2 days

*** Monitoring can also be done by an antigenic test or, failing that, PCR (in the latter case, the result must be obtained before classes resume)
