- Review educational results

In Doha College, as well as the full Board, there are 4 sub committees, with specific responsibilities Personally, I am member of Education Standards Committee, and the Governance Committee, and in Nov 2020, I took on the role of Chair of the Development Committee.

Over the past few years, the Development Committee has been intrinsically involved in the

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oversight of the project to relocate our Campus, which was successfully achieved this time last year. Over the last academic year, the committee has maintained continued focus on finalizing the project (snagging lists, approvals, signs off etc.), however as we enter this new academic year and the project nears final completion, the Development Committee will commence the new year with renewed focus on some of our other key objectives.

## **Development Committee Primary Objective:**

To support the College in achieving its Primary Objective, by focusing on leveraging stakeholder and wider community relationships and incubating early stage and/or multi-disciplinary initiatives supporting the strategic vision of the College. To oversee major projects and strategic initiatives delegated to it by the Board of Governors.
