Life is never dull in the CTE Innovation Lab! Our 3rd, 4th, and 5th graders have recently completed our PLTW (Project Lead the Way) computer science curriculum projects. The coding and computer design work our students produce continues to be very impressive. Have your student show you around the <a href="https://www.scratch.mit.edu">www.scratch.mit.edu</a> website sometime and show off their coding skills. Next up for our older students will be digging deep into our engineering standards. 3rd graders will be exploring forces and interactions. 4th graders are beginning to explore energy conversions, and our 5th graders are preparing themselves to immerse themselves into the world of robotics.

Our phenomenal K, 1st, and 2nd graders have been continuing to explore and collaborate in our lab space to develop their engineering and design skills through our weekly engineering challenges. We are lab and design thinking masters now and are ready to take on some greater engineering challenges. Our Kindergarten engineers are now building and experimenting experts which will come in handy as we are now starting to make a splash (literally) with our sinking and floating design unit from our curriculum partners at PLTW. The fantastic 1st graders are going to be building and exploring the engineering principles



surrounding the human skeletal system. Finally, our super 2nd graders are ready to take off as they explore the science of flight and glider design.

Life and learning is busy and exciting (as always) in our CTE STEAM program.
