

<p><b>Important Carpool Information!</b></p> 	<p>With the arrival of January and the potential for winter weather, please remember: Car rider line starts each morning at 7:15 a.m. with the tardy bell ringing at 7:45 a.m. Ideally, we welcome students into the building by 7:40 a.m. to allow them to be in class for a 7:45 a.m. start. The end of the day dismissal begins at 2:25 p.m. daily.</p> <p>A new city ordinance now restricts using neighborhood streets near school property as a school drop off alternative. This can cause traffic congestion and the potential for unsafe traffic movement around children where there is no additional supervision off school property. If you are using a car to get children to/from school, please follow the procedure to bring them in/pick up on school property in the lot to the east of the school/facing Hazel Dell Pkwy.</p> <p>We do our best each day to keep the line moving in an efficient way. You can help by having students ready to exit the car upon arrival, pulling all the way down in the morning to allow more cars to drop off and by having all students exit the passenger side of the car for safety. Thank you for your partnership in helping us welcome and safely deliver home 700+ students each day.</p>
<p><b>Bikers &amp; Walkers</b></p> 	<p>Please remember that students who walk or ride their bikes to school will not be able to enter the building until 7:35 a.m. With the colder, darker mornings we want to make sure that children are not standing outside for long periods of time. <b>Thanks so much for helping keep our CTE kids safe!</b></p>
<p><b>Reminder for Bus Riders</b></p> 	<p>Due to reduced bus routes and seats, students are not allowed to ride the bus home with a friend. It is recommended if students are getting together after school that they be picked up in the car rider line or dropped off directly at their friend's house by a parent/guardian.</p>

<p><b>Mask Reminder</b></p> 	<p>Please send your child(ren) to school with a mask and if you can, pack one or two extra in their backpack(s). We do have extras available in the office but our supply is dwindling. Thank you for your help with this!</p>
<p><b>Chromebooks</b></p> 	<p>Please remember to charge your Chromebooks every night! They are a very important part of our daily routine and need to be charged and ready to go at the beginning of each day.</p>
<p><b>Attendance</b></p> 	<p>Remember to please call us and let us know if your child will be absent or arriving late to school. Call 846-3086 and press <b>1</b> for attendance.</p> <p>Please make sure to leave to the reason for the <b>late arrival</b> or <b>all day absence</b></p>
<p><b>Covid Related Illnesses</b></p> 	<p>When reporting a Covid related illness, please email our school nurse at <a href="mailto:apertile@ccs.k12.in.us">apertile@ccs.k12.in.us</a> and leave a message on our attendance line. Please make sure to include a <b>return to school date</b> in both messages.</p> <p><i>*Return to school dates must be based on the new district guidelines.*</i></p>

Remind your students to check the Lost and Found! <b>Items not picked up by January 31st will be donated.</b></p> <p><i>**Please label all items such as coats, water bottles, jackets, and hats for the rest of the school year so they can be returned if found!</i></p>
<p><b>Parking Reminder</b></p> 	<p>With the cold weather our carpool line is getting longer every day. Please remember that if you are visiting the school or picking up your child early, we need to keep the front and bus parking lots clear. You are free to park in the staff lot (north side of building).</p>




Winners will be selected at random to win a Lego-tastic prize! We can't wait to build together!

Engineering Fair!**





POPs is always looking to add more male figures to our roster. There are fun upcoming events to help with and get together to be part of.


