 - ii. Will hire for youth minister in spring. Weekly youth group was restarted this evening with church volunteers as facilitators.

 - ii. Upper parking lot to be regraded, waiting on bid

 - ii. Budget set for next year for 410-420 students, numbers are strong for next year. Budget based on 65/35 split of students with parish member rate/non parish member rate. Max capacity in each classroom around 25 students, 22 in kindergarten. 2 Pre-K classrooms has contributed to increased enrollment
 - iii. Budget from Archdiocese pushed back to mid to late March
