However, if you choose to have your child miss a class or if your child is absent, you are still responsible for the fees.


Signing In & Out

Lower School students who are enrolled in Community School and/or Intramural Sports will be dismissed directly to Kid Power on their scheduled activity day. Kid Power is complimentary until the community school class or intramural sport begins. The instructor will pick up your child from Kid Power and escort them to their designated area for their class. Once the class is over, please meet your child at the Lower School front lobby doors for pick up. Parents/caregivers will be able to sign out their child out at the front desk or directly with the instructor. Any student who does not get picked up after their class is over will be sent back to Kid Power and the daily aftercare rate of \$25 will be applied to the child's account.

Middle and Upper School students are responsible for reporting to their community school class after school.
