Placement Testing Information

ACCUPLACER TESTING

- ACCUPLACER is not used like a traditional test. There is generally no "passing score." Rather, ACCUPLACER scores indicate areas in which you are strong and areas in which you may need help.
- Incoming students must take the ACCUPLACER placement test unless they have ACT scores or college credit that waives this requirement. (ACT scores are valid for 2 years.)
- As a service to students there is no fee charged.
- ACCUPLACER test results places you in the reading, writing and math courses that will provide greater success in your future course work.
- The test is not timed, and generally takes 90 minutes to complete.
