GENERAL RULES:

1. Applicant must be a son or daughter of a parent or guardian who is a member of Clay County Farm Bureau and one who will have finished High school within the year he or she applies for the scholarship.
 2. Applicant must be outstanding in character, have a good scholastic record, and must maintain a "C" average in college work.
 3. Recipient must enter college as beginning freshmen no later than the fall semester after high school graduation. Unless circumstances beyond his or her control, such as serious illness or injury, prevents his or her doing so. In such case, the recipient must enter college by the spring semester the following year or the award will go to the first alternate.
 4. After recipient accepts the award and enters college, dropping out of school, except for serious illness or injury, will cause the recipient to lose the award.
 5. This scholarship would not be awarded to the recipient, if the recipient received a full scholarship elsewhere. However, receipt of this award shall not prevent the recipient from accepting other scholarships. Recipient is eligible for only one Farm Bureau Scholarship.
 6. Recipient may enter the college of his or her choice.
 7. Applicant's parent or guardian must have an active membership and active policy with Clay County Farm Bureau for at least 6 months prior, for the applicant to apply for the scholarship and must continue to do so through the life of the scholarship.
 8. Application must be received by the Clay County Farm Bureau or postmarked no later than the first Monday in April of the year the student will be applying.
 9. Once the applicant receives the scholarship, a copy of their grades must be turned in to the County Secretary, scholarship grades are not required for the first new semester because they are turned in with the scholarship application, but are required by the recipient to have grades turned in by July 31st and December 31st.
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10. Scholarship will pay if awarded \$250.00 a semester.
