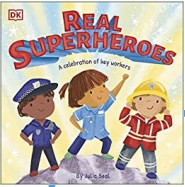


Reception Term 4 - Overview



Writing

This term the children will be developing their writing skills in writing facts they have learnt about 'Real Life Superheroes'. Children will write sentences in meaningful contexts and apply their phonic knowledge to write in ways which match their spoken sounds. Children will also develop their common word knowledge and spelling. Each week, children will learn about a different profession and create posters about what they do and how they do it.

Understanding of the World — Technology

Throughout the term, children will develop their ability to use programmable toys. Children will experiment with different ways to make these move, forwards, backwards, turning, left and right. Children will plan and create simple journeys for this toy.



Understanding of the World

The children will be looking at different occupations and ways of life throughout the term. Children will show an interest in different occupations through role play opportunities and meeting people from different professions. Children will begin to show a good understanding of what they do and how they work.



Reading

Over the term, the children will be learning about a range of different professions. Children will be exposed to a range of Non-Fiction books based around these professions and children will be taught how to gather information from these books. Children will continue to use their phonic knowledge to decode and read words and show a good understanding of what they have read.

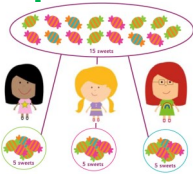
Physical Development

The children will be developing their skills in the 'Physical Cog'. Children will be able to perform a small range of skills and link two movements together. They will also be able to perform skills or movements with some control. Through health and safety, children will be developing their understanding of transporting and storing equipment safely.



Maths

Children will continue to develop their number knowledge up to 20, with a focus on finding missing numbers up to 20. They will be confident in recognising and using these numbers. Children will also start to develop their understanding of doubling, halving and sharing. Children will also be introduced to the concept of odd and even numbers be able to sort numbers into those that are odd or even.



Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Children will become more confident in initiating conversations and asking questions of others. They will develop their skills when speaking to others about their own wants, needs, interests and opinions and show understanding that not everyone enjoys the same things. Through the topic children will learn about adapting their behaviour to different events and situations.



Expressive Arts and Design

Children will be focussing on developing their painting skills. Children will be focus on colour mixing and paintbrush skills and then creating different colours for a purpose. Children will use their painting skills to paint their own picture of a 'real—life superhero'.
