PreKindergarten for ages 4 and 5

Our prekindergarten classes expose children to a variety of experiences that promote social skills and enhance learning. Children learn and grow in a structured preschool environment that fosters readiness skills that will help them in kindergarten. **Children must be four by Sept. 1, 2022.**

ThreeSchool

Three's preschool has a focus on social skills, exposure to a variety of learning materials, and increasing language skills. **Children must be three by Sept. 1, 2022.**

All children must be toilet trained to attend classes.

How do I register?

If your child would benefit from a preschool experience and fits the criteria mentioned above, fill out this form and mail or drop off at the address indicated or fax both sides to the Fax number indicated. **Your child will be added to a pre-approval list until a class placement is available.**

What is the cost of this preschool program?

Full tuition for a two day per week class is \$160 per month. The three day per week class is \$224 per month and a five day per week class is \$360 half day and \$980 full day per month.

Minnesota School Readiness state funding allows the district to provide limited financial assistance in our preschool programs.

Families must provide proof of income and meet eligibility guidelines to qualify.

Priority is given to children who are learning English, referred by screening or have other significant personal or financial need.

Limited tuition assistance is available based on family size and total yearly household income. Use the scale below to determine monthly tuition. Proof of income is required. Call 651-403-8353 with questions.
