**Year 8 Curriculum Evening – An Online Explanation of the Year 9 Curriculum

Kineton High School is determined that all of its students will have the optimum number of choices for post 16 and post 18 pathways.

Recently, in their Character & Culture lessons, students in Year 8 have been exploring some of the issues relating to employability in the 21<sup>st</sup> century, such as the need for a broad and balanced curriculum and a wide range of skills in order to adapt to the ever changing workplace.

Today, in Character & Culture, they explored how what they have learned will help them when they come to choose the subjects they wish to study in Year 9 (and possibly beyond). They were also shown how to make their choices, and took part in a 'practice exercise' to ensure they understand the process.
