

ERI or Early Reading Intervention works with students on identifying letters and their corresponding sounds through a variety of activities and repetitions. As students gain mastery of letters and their sounds relations they begin to work on identifying beginning and ending sounds and tapping and blending those words together.

Here are some activities you can do at home with your child to help with their instruction:

- Identifying the beginning sounds of objects in the home...what if the first sound in bed: /b/
- When reading a book to your child, point to a letter and have them identify the name and sound.
