

Words Their Way works with spelling patterns in words. Students focus on one spelling pattern at a time using multiple strategies to help spell and recognize these words. Activities can include finding words with specific patterns within the text, building words with magnet letters or white boards, or completing sort pages where they must match a picture with the spelling patterns they hear within the word.

Activities that can help your child at home include:

- Writing spelling words in a fun way ie. writing them in shaving cream, with finger paint or in sand outside.
- Reading books that have rhyming words such as Dr. Seuss and have students identify what spelling or rhyme patterns are being used.
- Looking online for sorts covering a vowel pattern and completing them together.
