

Early Literacy Skill Building program (ELSB) is a comprehensive reading program that looks at moving students to better comprehend a text. In this program we work on high frequency sight words, letter sound correspondence, reading comprehension and writing skills. This intervention looks at all aspects of reading and how to tie it together to become a fluent reading and comprehend a text.

You can help your child at home by:

- Reading a story multiple times together and ask questions each time about what was read.
- Tapping out the sounds of words/items in the grocery store or when doing a family outing in order to practice decoding words.
- Completing a daily journal, have your child think about their day and write one to two sentences summarizing it in a journal, (this also becomes a great keepsake for when they get older).
