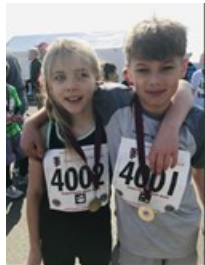
Academy updates

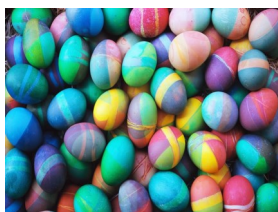


Egg roll and easter bonnet parade—Friday 1st April
