SCHOOL BUS SAFE-RIDING RULES



- 1. Students should arrive at assigned bus stop five minutes before the bus is scheduled to arrive.
- 2. Students must wait at their "Designated Place of Safety" location staying clear and safe of traffic, and board only with the driver's direction.
- 3. Behavior at a school bus stop must not threaten life, limb, or property of any individual.
- 4. Students should go directly to an available or assigned seat and sit down immediately.
- 5. Students must remain seated, keeping aisles and exits clear, and remain in the proper seating position facing forward.
- 6. Students should observe classroom conduct and obey the bus drivers promptly and respectfully.
- 7. Students should use appropriate language (profanity and obscene gestures are strictly prohibited) and maintain an appropriate level of talk.
- 8. Students are not allowed to eat or drink on the bus.
- 9. Students are not to have in their possession:
 - a. tobacco, alcohol, drugs, or weapons
 - b. glass items, toy weapons-including toy guns, animals-including insects, or balls of any kind.
- 10. Students should never throw or pass objects on the school bus, from the school bus, or out of the school bus.
- 11. Students should only bring objects that can be carried on their laps.
- 12. Students must board and/or depart the school bus at assigned locations unless they have preapproval from their parents or administrative permission to do otherwise.
- 13. Students must keep their entire body inside the school bus at all times.
