

#### **National Merit FINALISTS!**

Two of our seniors, Rose Hewald and Ellye Steinberg, have been named National Merit FINALISTS! In September 2021, they were named among the 16,000 Semifinalists across the country who had the opportunity to continue in the competition for National Merit Scholarships worth nearly \$30 million.
