### In Our Classrooms

At West Oxford Elementary School, our teachers will work with students and their families to support students' success in the Common Core Standards for reading and math. Some of our key connections with families will be:

- Develop goals with students that focus on increasing their skill in solving word problems. Send goals to parents along with some practical ideas for supporting their learning goals at home.

### At Home

Some of our key at-home activities will be:

- Use the weekly packet or google classroom to discuss my child's learning goals and to support my child's learning at home.

- Read with my child for twenty minutes every day and talk about how the story connects with things that he or she has experienced.
- Use the math goals and related games or strategies the teacher sends home to improve my child's math word problem solving skills.
