English Language Proficiency Level 3 - Developing	 Follow two-step oral directions, one step at a time Respond non-verbally to confirm or deny facts (e.g., thumbs up, thumbs down) 	Make predictions (e.g., "It's sunny today. Tomorrow it might") Answer explicit questions from stories read aloud (e.g., who, what or where)	Use pictures to identify words Classify visuals according to labels or icons (e.g., animals v. plants)	Communicate using letters, symbols and numbers in context Reproduce familiar words from labeled models or illustrations
English Language Proficiency Level 4 – Expanding	 Find pictures that match oral descriptions Follow oral directions and compare with visual or nonverbal models (e.g., "Draw a circle under the line.") 	Retell narrative picture stories through pictures with emerging detail Sing repetitive songs and chants independently	Identify some high-frequency words in context Match pictures to phrases/short sentences	Label familiar people and objects from models Produce symbols and invented spelling associated with pictures
English Language Proficiency Level 5 - Bridging	 Order pictures of events according to sequential language Identify pictures/ realia associated with grade- level academic concepts from oral descriptions 	Tell original stories with emerging detail Explain situations (e.g., involving feelings)	Differentiate between letters, words and sentences String words together to make short sentences	Create content-based representations through pictures and words Make "story books" with drawings and words
