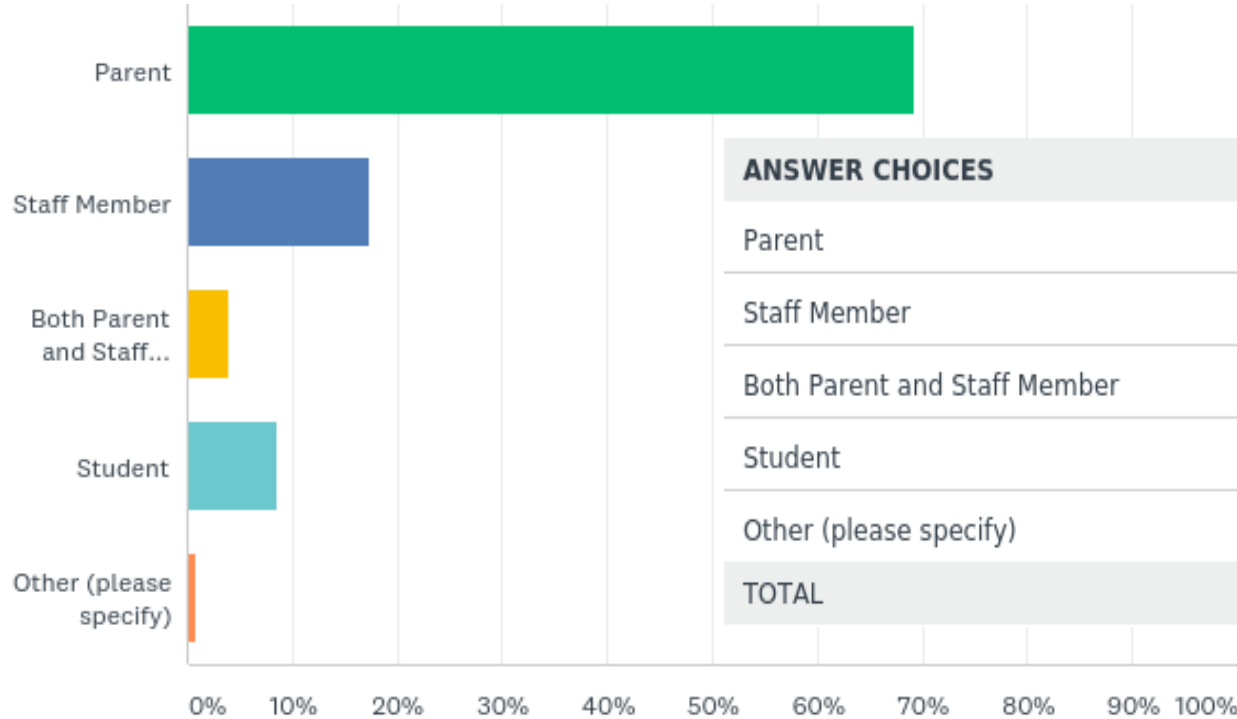

# Q1: What type of school community member are you?

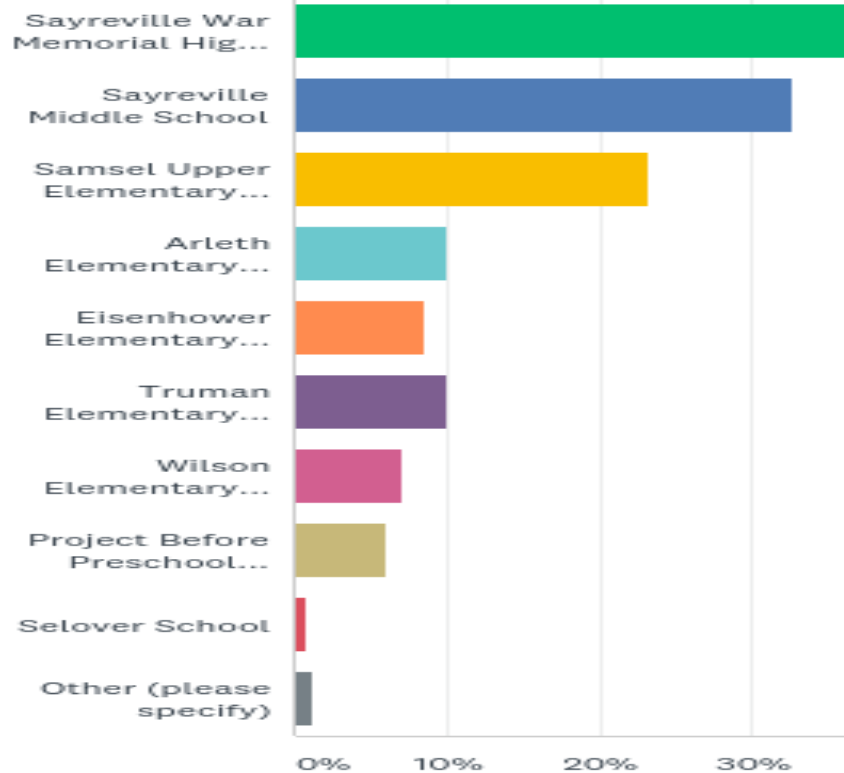

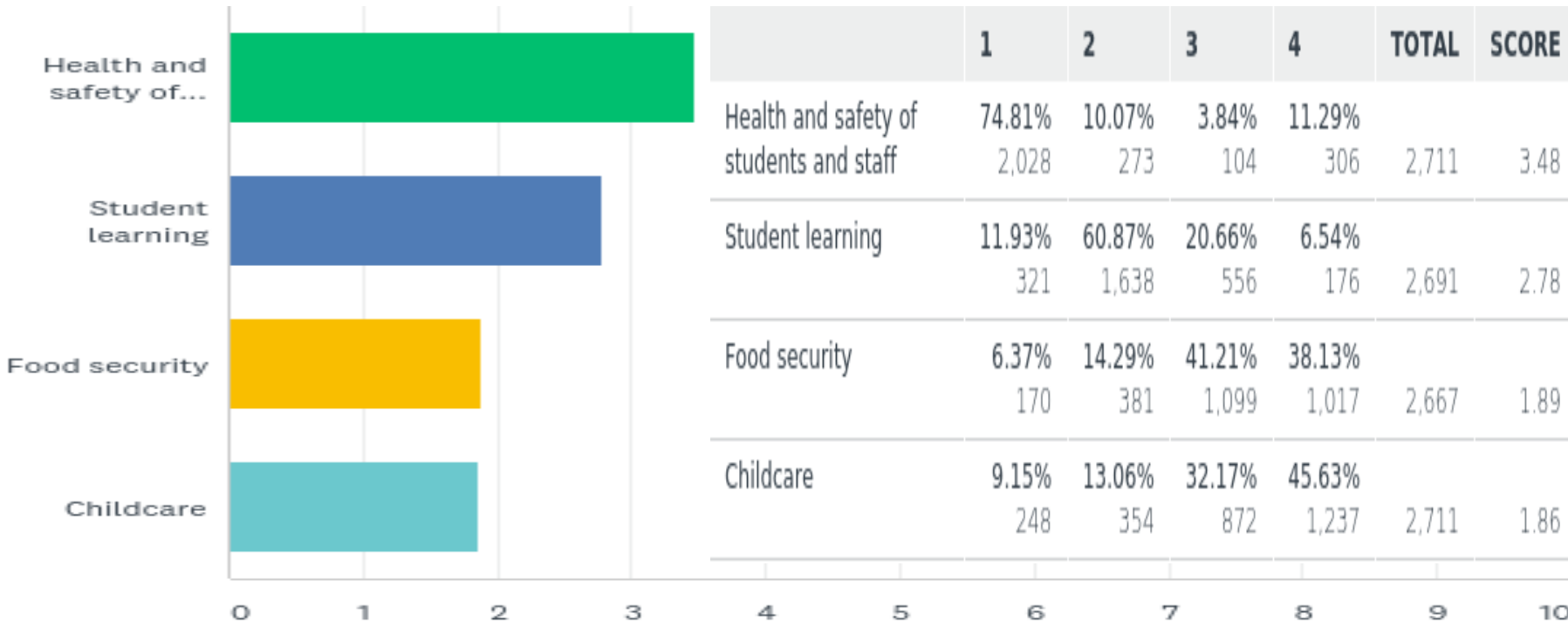

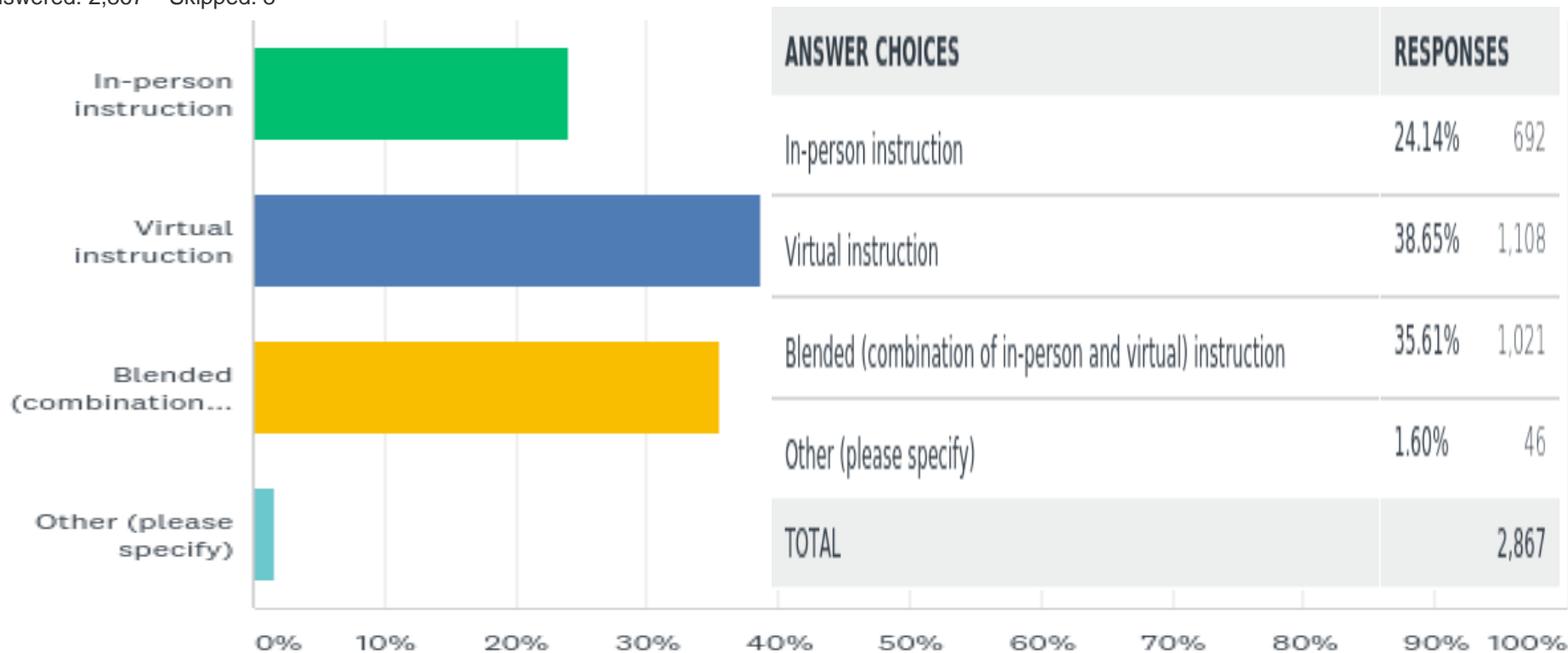
# Q3: Under the current pandemic and economic circumstances, rank the below needs or concerns you possess from most important (1) to least important (4).

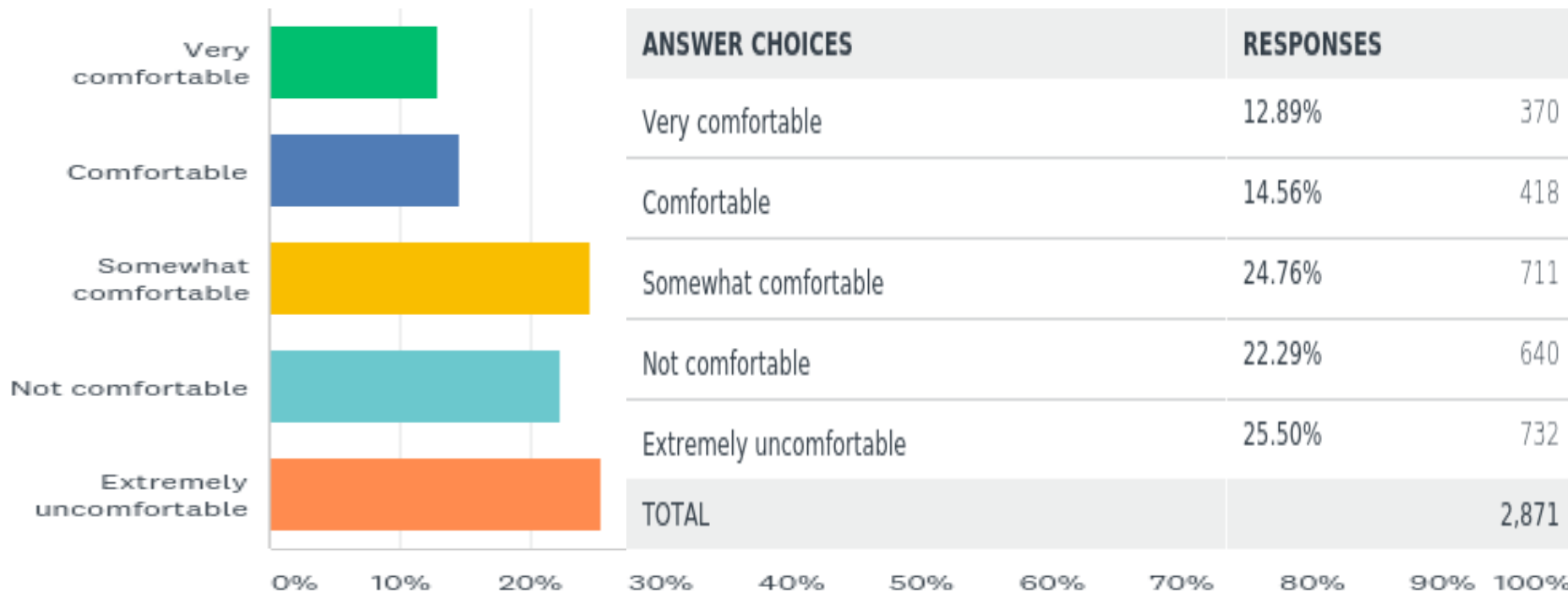
# Q4: Under the current circumstances, which form of learning is most aligned with the needs or concerns you prioritized above?

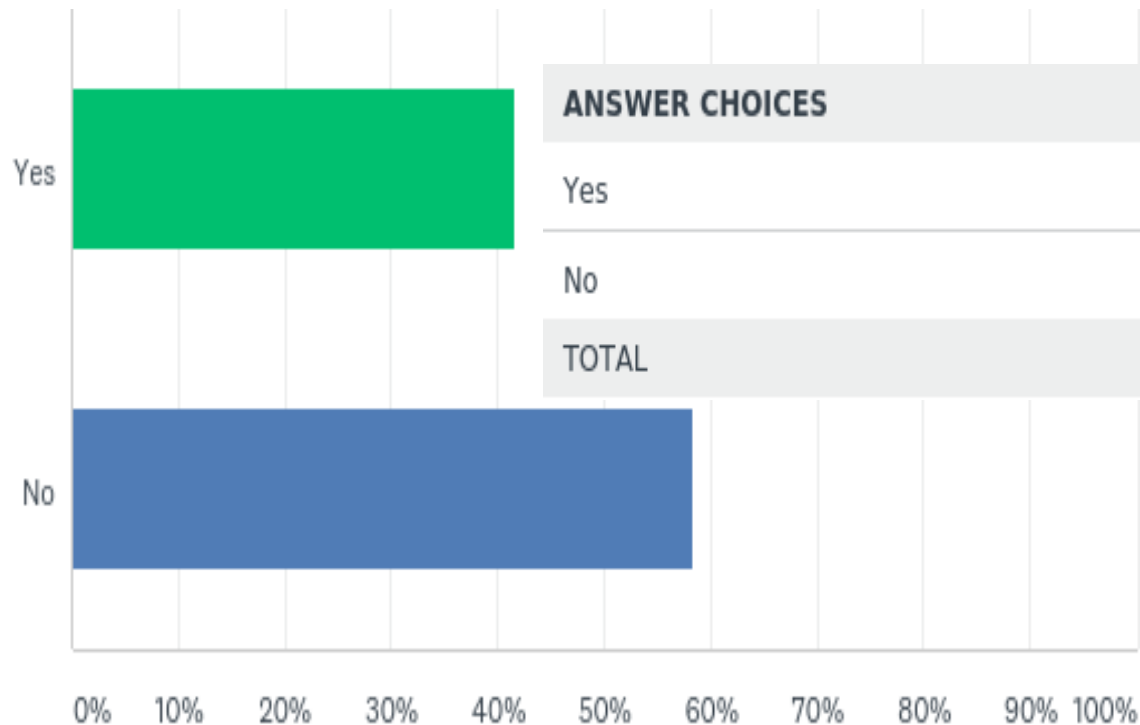
# Q5: How comfortable are you with students and instructional staff returning to our schools in September for in-person instruction with strict social distancing guidelines and personal protective equipment?

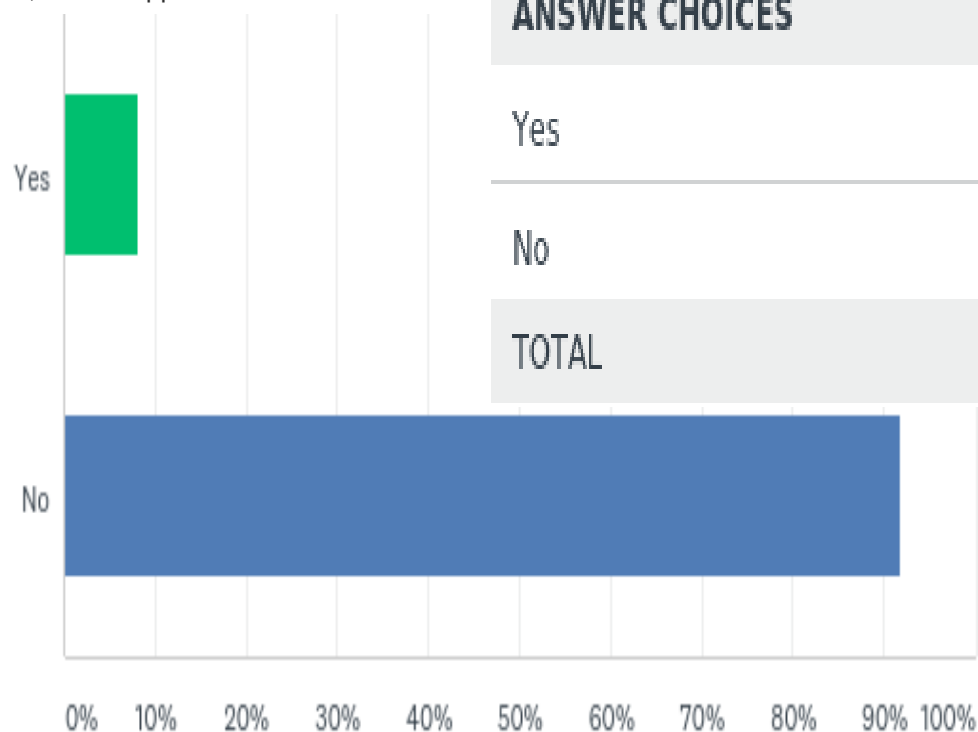
## Q6: Do you or does anyone in your household have a compromised immune system and/or an underlying medical condition?

# Q7: Do you or does your child have a documented medical reason that would prohibit you or her/him from being able to wear a mask?

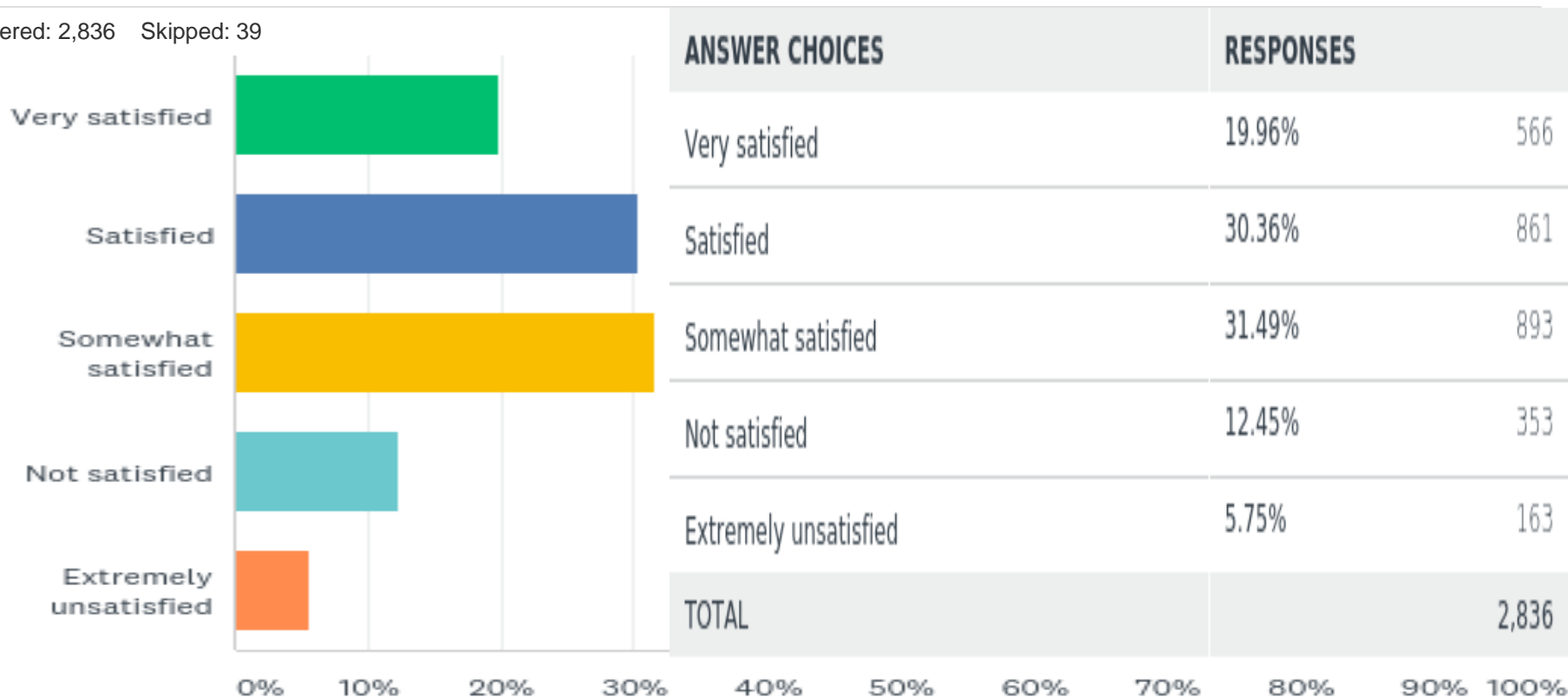

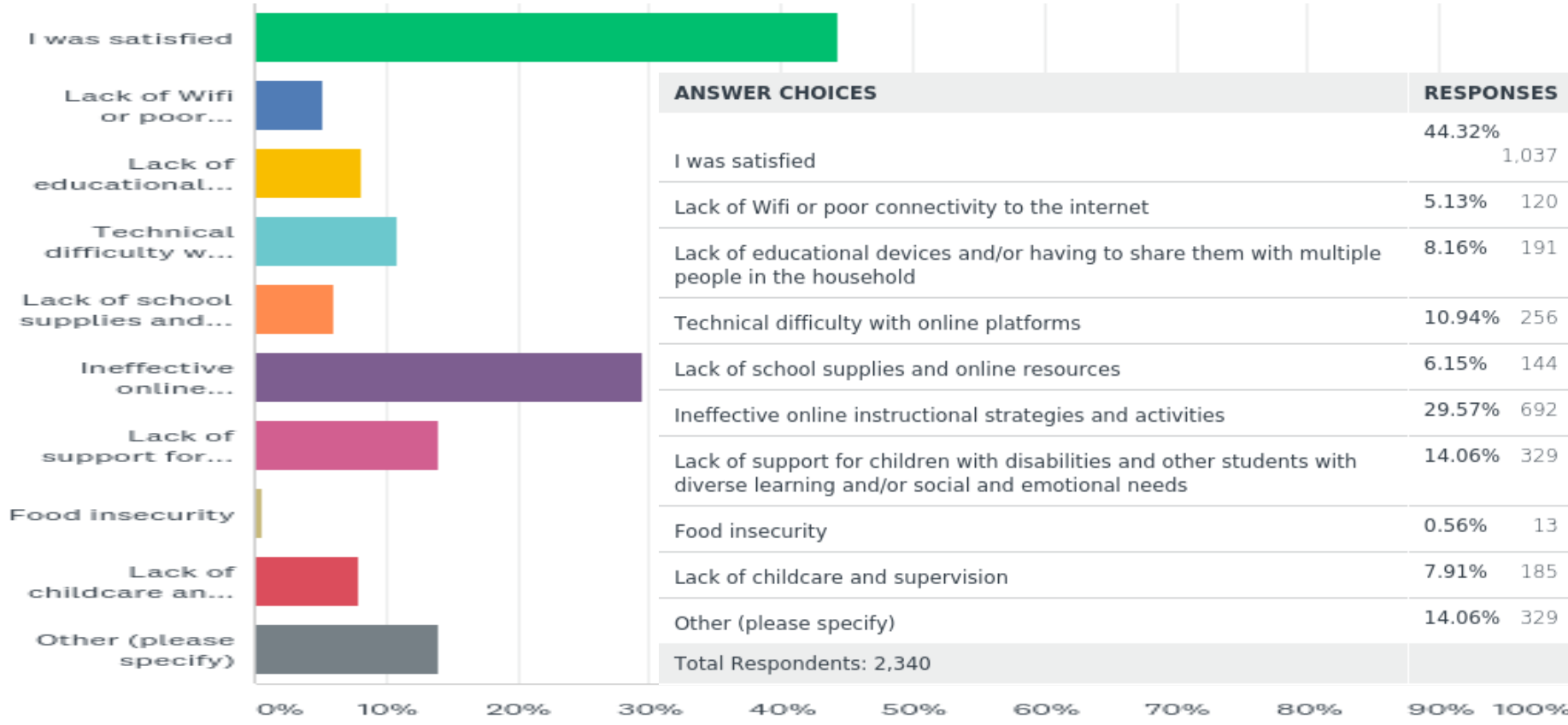
## Q8: How satisfied were you with the level of virtual or online instruction that you provided and/or that your or your child(ren) received last spring?

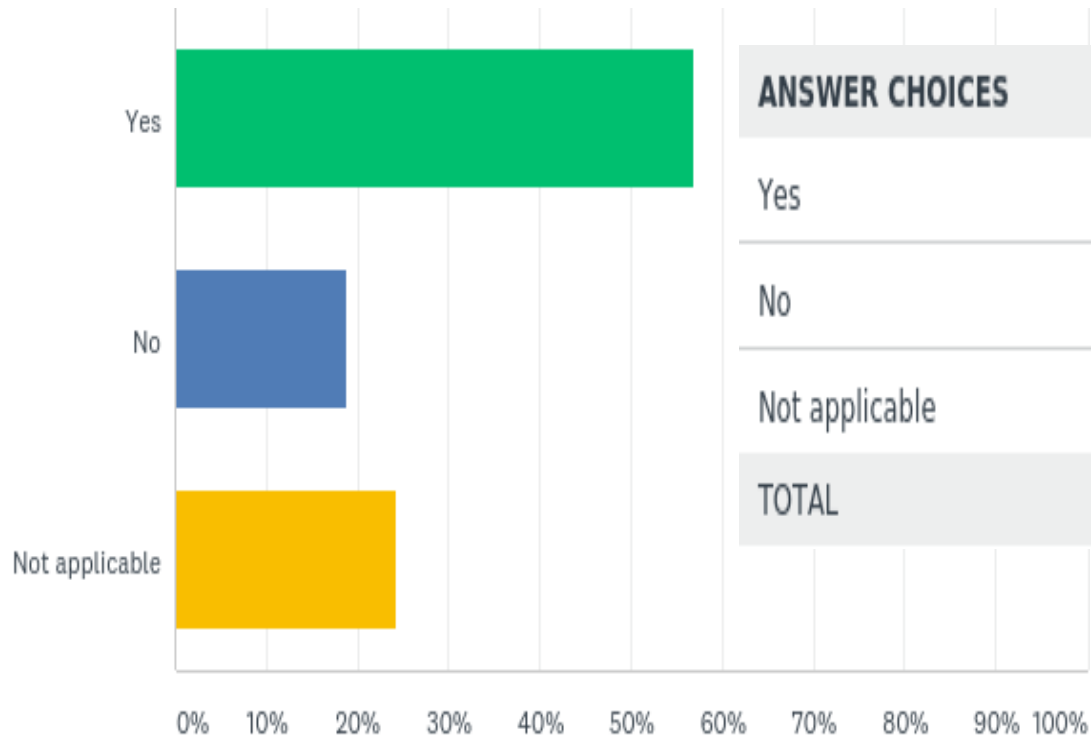
# Q9: If you were unsatisfied, select the most prominent reasons why.

# Q10: Is your child eligible to receive district busing services this year (2020-21)?

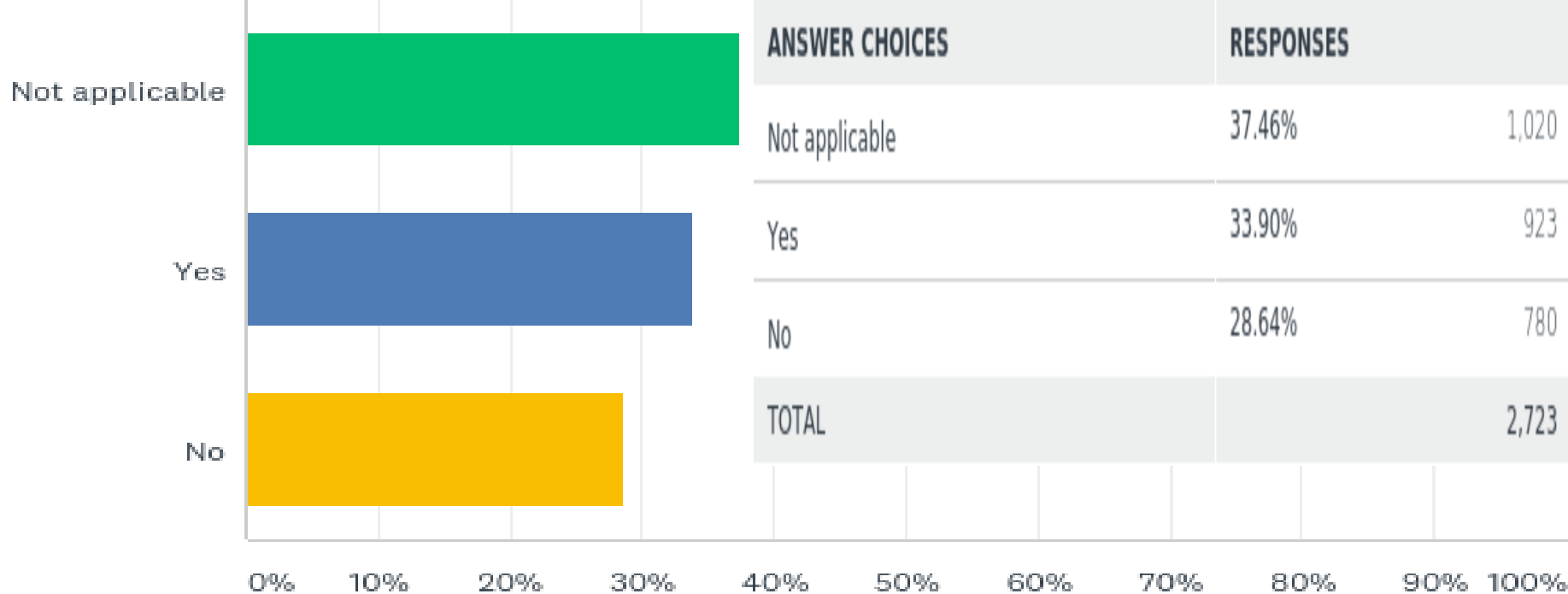

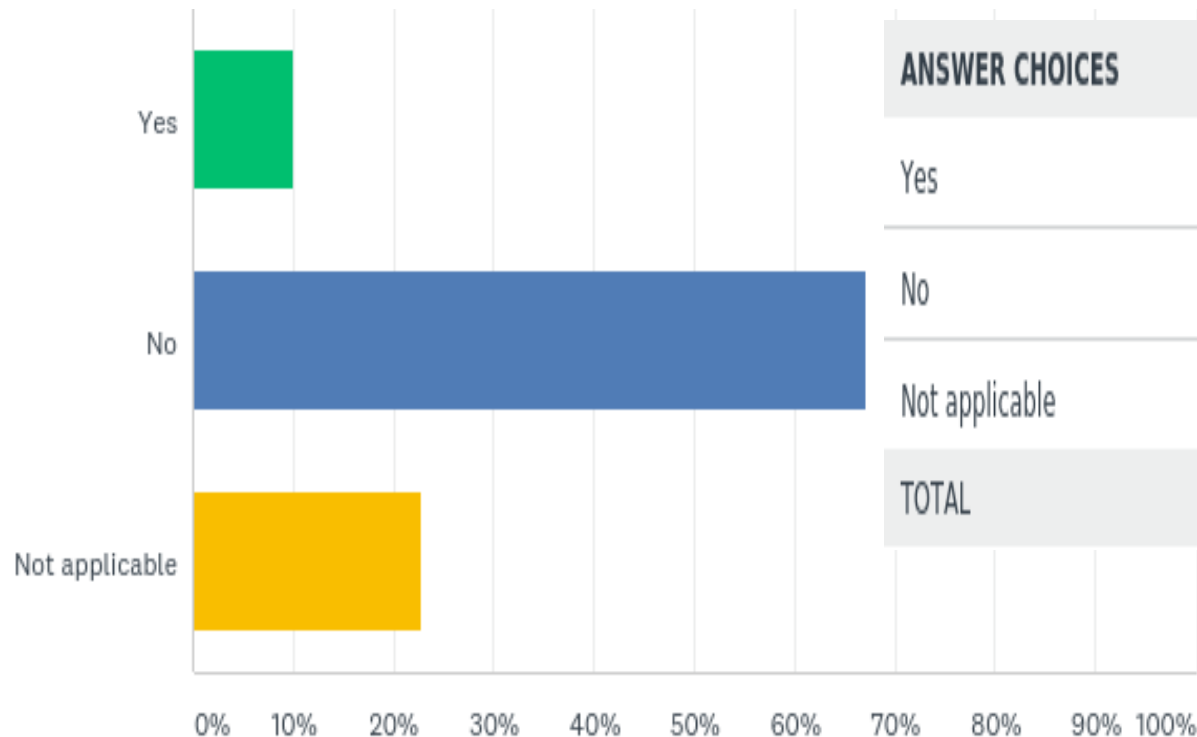

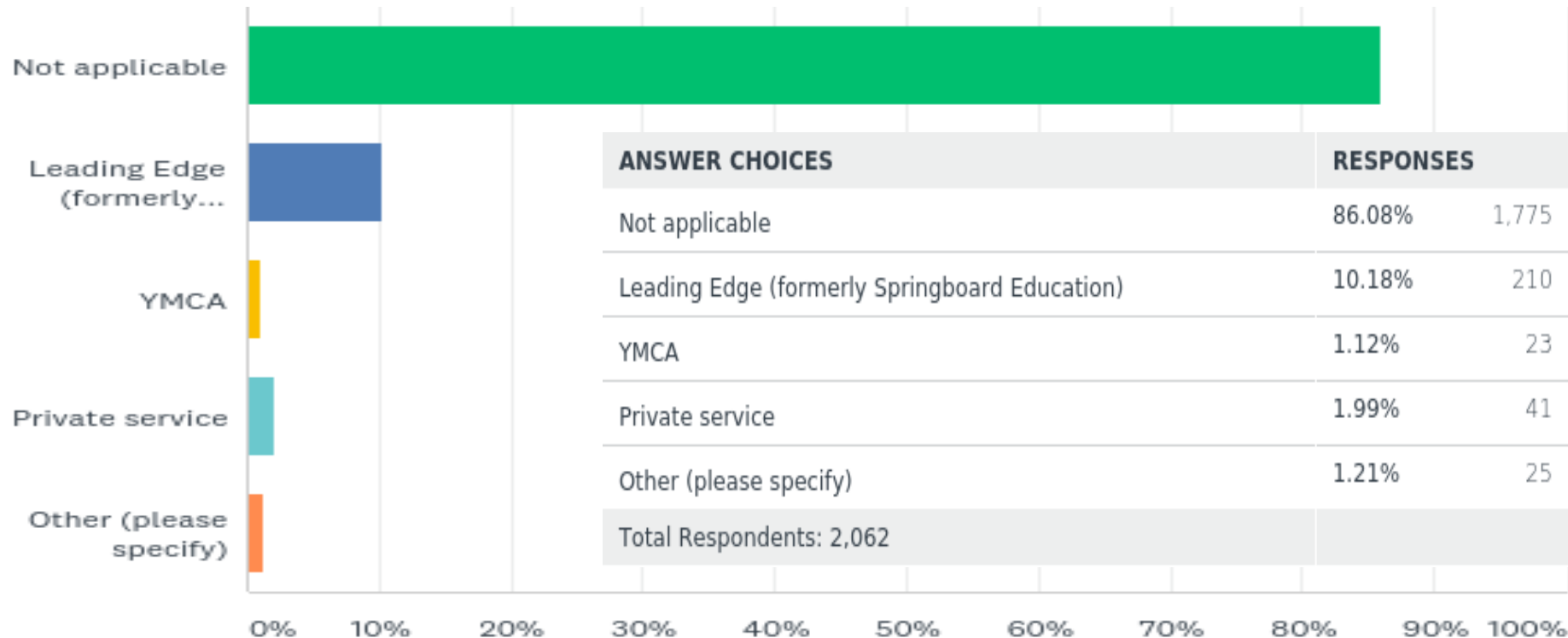

# Q13: If you answered yes, which service provider do you currently pay for?

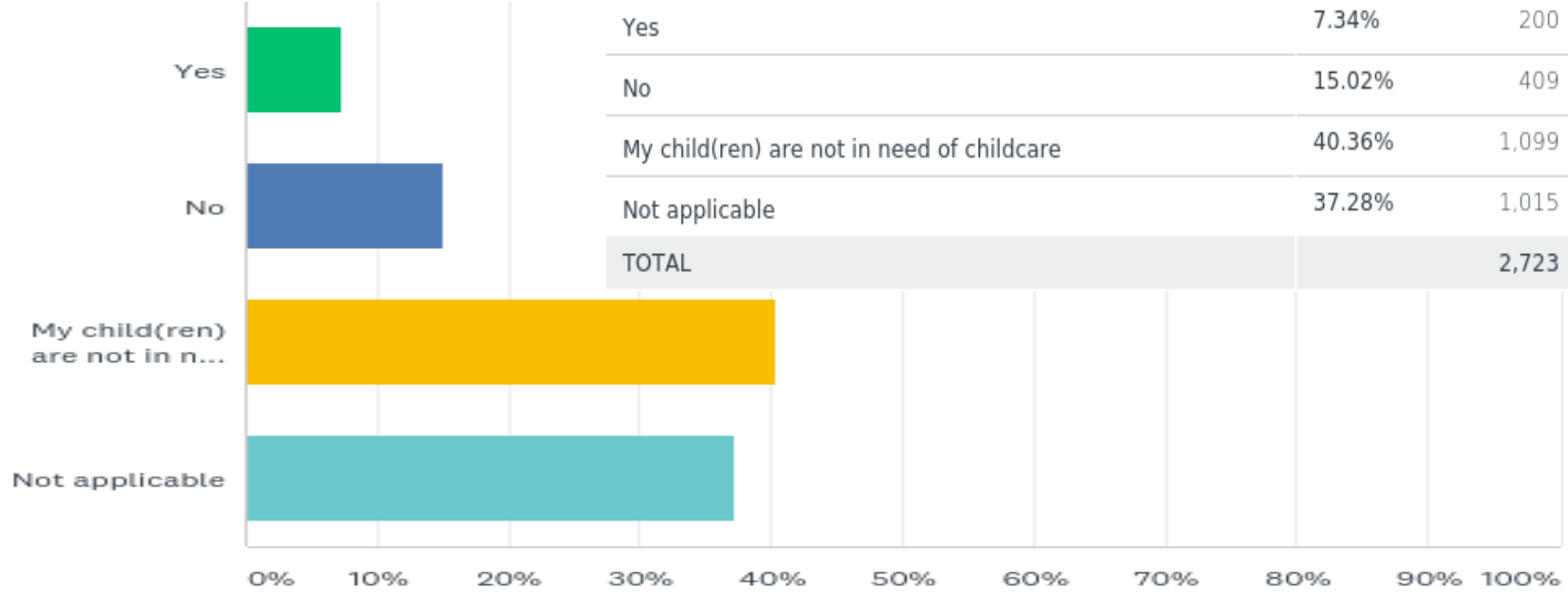

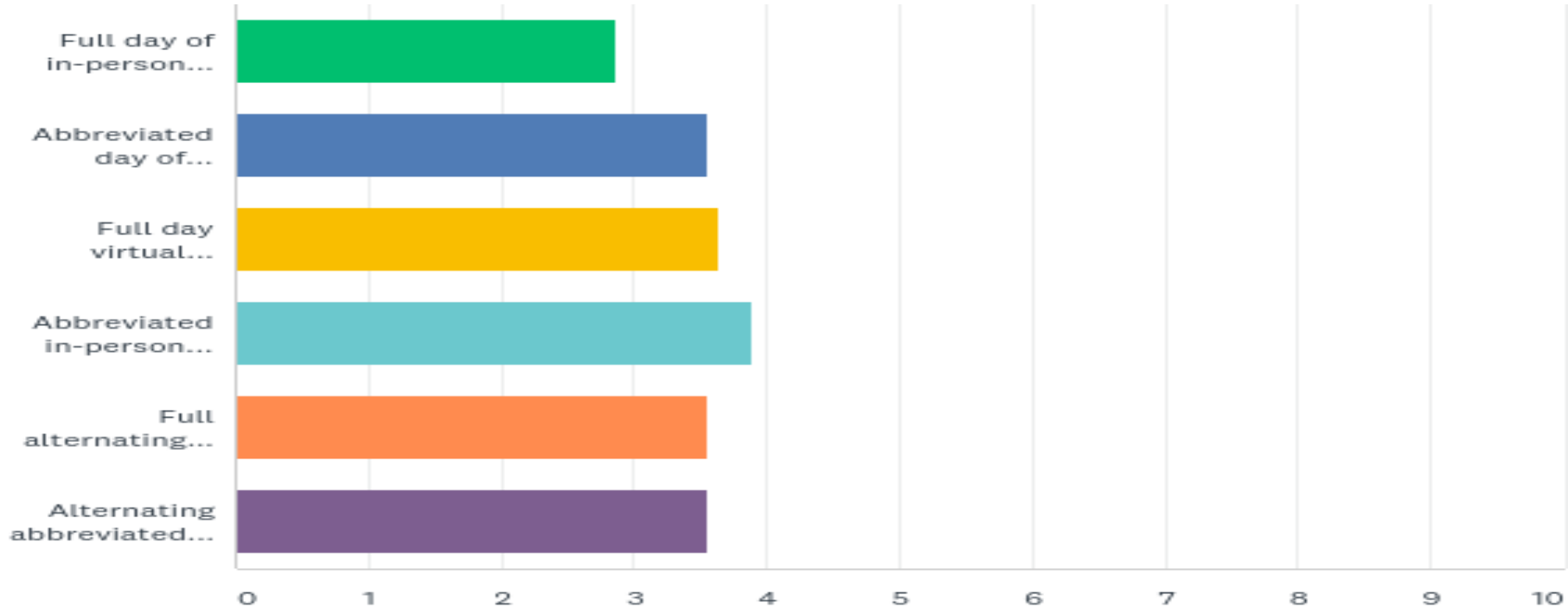
