FINANCE

40. The Superintendent recommends and so moves the Board of Education of Sayreville to approve the donation of one air conditioner to the Sayreville Middle School. The donation consists of one LG Air Conditioner at 24,500 BTUs, model number LW2416ER. The air conditioner will be donated by the Sayreville Middle School PTO for the NEW staff work & wellness room.

41. The Superintendent recommends and so moves the Board of Education of Sayreville to approve the purchase of mobile surveillance equipment for the Transportation Fleet from AngelTrax through the HCESC award for Fleet Tracking & Management Systems bid number HCESC-Trans-18C (34HUNCCP), for a total cost of \$73,064.92.

The Summer Learning Series is a professional development program designed to provide teachers practical ideas and strategies for effective teaching in a blended and distance learning environment. **RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AGREEMENT FOR CERTAIN
LEGAL SERVICES ADOPTED BY THE BOARD OF EDUCATION
OF THE BOROUGH OF SAYREVILLE IN THE
COUNTY OF MIDDLESEX**

WHEREAS, there exists a need for specialized legal services in connection with the ESIP program and the authorization and the issuance of obligations of The Board of Education of The Borough of Sayreville in the County of Middlesex, (the “Board”), a body corporate of the State of New Jersey, including the review of such procedures and the rendering of approving legal opinions acceptable to the financial community; and

WHEREAS, such special legal services can be provided only by a recognized Bond Counsel firm, and the law firm of McManimon, Scotland & Baumann, LLC, Roseland, New Jersey is so recognized by the financial community; and

WHEREAS, the fee will be \$15,000.00 plus \$1.00 per thousand dollars of securities issued and funds will be available for this purpose through the funding of the ESIP program;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE BOROUGH OF SAYREVILLE IN THE COUNTY OF MIDDLESEX, AS FOLLOWS:

The law firm of McManimon, Scotland & Baumann, LLC, Roseland, New Jersey is hereby retained to provide specialized legal services necessary in connection with the ESIP program and the authorization and the issuance of obligations of the Board in accordance with an Agreement dated as of July 22, 2020 and submitted to the Board (the “Contract”).

The Contract is awarded without competitive bidding as a “Professional Service” in accordance with the Public School Contracts Law, N.J.S.A.18A:18A-5(a)(1), because it is for services performed by persons authorized by law to practice a recognized profession.

A copy of this resolution as well as the Contract shall be placed on file with the Secretary of the Board.

A notice in accordance with the Public School Contracts Law of New Jersey in the form attached hereto shall be published in the Home News Tribune.

44. The Superintendent recommends and so moves the Board of Education of Sayreville to approve a contract with Acacia Financial Group, Inc. to serve as Financial Advisors on the ESIP program in the amount of \$8,500.00, funds will be available through the funding of the ESIP Program.

Lightbridge Academy to provide preschool programming for Sayreville resident students not to exceed **\$360,000.00**, using Preschool Expansion Aid.

The Learning Experience to provide preschool programming for Sayreville resident students not to exceed **\$180,000.00**, using Preschool Expansion Aid.

Acelero Learning Monmouth/Middlesex County, Inc./Head Start Grantee to provide preschool programming for Sayreville resident students not to exceed **\$600,000.00**, using Preschool Expansion Aid.
