WHEREAS, the Sayreville Board of Education (“Board”), solicited and received competitive quotes for financing of the Board’s lease purchase of Technology Equipment and School Buses (“Project”); and

WHEREAS, the lowest responsible and responsive quote for the Project was submitted by US Bancorp Government Leasing & Finance, Inc.;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board hereby: Awards a contract to US Bancorp Government Leasing & Finance, Inc. to provide lease purchase financing to the Board in a principal amount up to \$733,158.18 and an effective interest rate of 1.2789% for the principal amount of \$733,158.18 over a five year period, in accordance with the terms of the quote documents; and

Authorizes US Bancorp Government Leasing & Finance, Inc., upon closing, to forward the financing proceeds directly to the Board; and

Authorizes the Business Administrator and the Board attorney to take all steps necessary and appropriate to carry out this action of the Board.
