30. The Superintendent recommends and so moves the Board of Education of Sayreville to approve the contract with Jones Turf Management, Inc. for the Sayreville War Memorial High School Baseball Field Improvements in the amount of \$188,971.00. The district unsuccessfully bid this project on three occasions and negotiated the cost and specifications in a competitive manner.

31. The Superintendent recommends and so moves the Board of Education of Sayreville to approve a withdrawal from Maintenance Reserve in the amount of \$188,971.00. The withdrawal of funds will be used for the Sayreville War Memorial High School Baseball Field Improvements. Any funds not expended will be returned to Maintenance Reserve.

32. The Superintendent recommends and so moves the Board of Education of Sayreville to approve the rejection of all bids in response to the Samsel Upper Elementary School Parking Lot Expansion bids received on July 9, 2019, as the low bid substantially exceeds the cost estimate for the project. The district has bid this project on two occasions and will negotiate the project with the previous bidders so that the project meets the specifications and is within the cost estimate.

33. The Superintendent recommends and so moves the Board of Education of Sayreville to approve the contract with James R. Ientile, Inc., for the Samsel Upper Elementary School Parking Lot Expansion in the amount of \$455,875.00. NOW THEREFORE, be it RESOLVED by the Sayreville Board of Education in Sayreville, NJ, County of Middlesex, as follows:

- a. The sale of the surplus property shall be conducted through GovDeals pursuant to State Contract A-83453/T2581 in accordance with the terms and conditions of the State Contract. The terms and conditions of the agreement entered into with GovDeals is available online at govdeals.com and also available from the Board.
- b. The sale will be conducted online and the address of the auction site is govdeals.com.
- c. The sale is being conducted pursuant to Local Finance Notice 2008-9.
- d. A list of the surplus property to be sold as attached, includes textbooks and workbooks.
- e. The surplus property as identified shall be sold in an “as-is” condition without express or implied warranties with the successful bidder required to execute a Hold Harmless and Indemnification Agreement concerning use of said surplus property.
- f. The Board reserves the right to accept or reject any bid submitted.
- g. If the Board is unsuccessful in selling the surplus property the items will be disposed of.
