FINANCE

**RESOLUTION TO AWARD A CONTRACT
FOR THE LEASE PURCHASE FINANCING OF TECHNOLOGY EQUIPMENT,

WHEREAS, the Sayreville Board of Education (“Board”), solicited and received bids for financing of the Board’s lease purchase of Technology Equipment, School Buses, Facilities Improvements and Facility Equipment (“Project”); and

WHEREAS, the lowest responsible and responsive bid for the Project was submitted by Municipal Leasing Consultants;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board hereby: Awards a contract to Municipal Leasing Consultants to provide lease purchase financing to the Board in a principal amount up to \$2,149,752.01 and an effective interest rate of 2.199% for the principal amount of \$1,163,903.01 over a three year period and 2.279% for the principal amount of \$985,849.00 over a five year period, in accordance with the terms of the quote documents; and

Authorizes Municipal Leasing Consultants, upon closing, to forward the financing proceeds directly to the Board; and

Authorizes the Business Administrator and the Board attorney to take all steps necessary and appropriate to carry out this action of the Board.
