FINANCE

25. The Superintendent recommends and so moves the Board of Education of Sayreville to approve the following resolution:

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Sayreville Board of Education to approve the submission of the “Renovations at Sayreville Middle School” to the New Jersey Department of Education, DOE State Project # 23-4660-055-19-1000, for review and Department approval of an “other maintenance project” with no state funding and amendment of the 2010 long range facilities plan to be consistent with the project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Board authorizes Spiezle Architectural Group Inc. to make the submission to the Department of Education on behalf of the district.

26. The Superintendent recommends and so moves the Board of Education of Sayreville to approve the following resolution:

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Sayreville Board of Education to approve the submission of the “Alterations at Truman Elementary School” to the New Jersey Department of Education, DOE State Project # 23-4660-075-19-2000, for review and Department approval of an “other capital project” with no state funding and amendment of the 2010 long range facilities plan to be consistent with the project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Board authorizes Spiezle Architectural Group Inc. to make the submission to the Department of Education on behalf of the district.

The Superintendent recommends and so moves the Board of Education of Sayreville to approve the submission of an amended application for funding under the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) and the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). The district received additional funding through the School Improvement Award (SIA) to help the Sayreville Middle School meet the progress goals in the Title I Program Plan. The additional funding received is \$56,281. The total amount of the ESEA Consolidated Grant for FY2019 is \$1,142,804.

The Superintendent recommends and so moves the Board of Education of Sayreville to approve the use of Non-Public Title IA funds to the following teachers to provide a Title IA tutorial program for eligible Sayreville students at St. Stanislaus Kostka School for the 2018 - 2019 school year. The teachers will be paid at the rate of \$45/hour.
