

Cloverleaf Access and Admissions Policy

Statement:

Cloverleaf Elementary values the International Baccalaureate Primary Years Programme and its engaging and challenging curriculum, which encourages critical thinking, intercultural understanding, and respect. We welcome enrollment from any K-5 student in Iredell-Statesville Schools.

Admission Requirements:

Admission to Cloverleaf is based on living in the boundaries of the Cloverleaf district or being able to provide transportation if you live outside of those boundaries. Students within those boundaries are automatically granted admission. Students living outside the school boundaries will be granted admission as school choice students while seats are available. If there should be more out of district applicants than available seats, a lottery will be held to determine admission.

Students within the boundaries of the Iredell-Statesville Schools or Mooresville Graded Schools will pay no tuition to attend Cloverleaf. Students from outside of Iredell County are welcome to attend provided required payment of a yearly fee, as is the case for all out of county applicants to schools within the Iredell Statesville School system.

Additional Documentation:

Cloverleaf requires the students to submit their transfer information and other supporting documents required by Iredell Statesville Schools (such as proof of address, student physical/immunization records) at the time of admission.
