KSD COVID Mitigation Procedures

Revised: 3/8/2022 EFFECTIVE: 4/4/2022



1. COVID Vaccination

a. CDC recognizes that the COVID vaccination is the number one mitigation strategy available. KSD strongly encourages eligible staff and students to be vaccinated.

2. Consistent and correct mask use

a. Effective 4/4/2022, masks are optional for students and staff.

3. Hand washing and respiratory etiquette

- a. Staff will teach and reinforce hand washing with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.
- b. Staff will remind everyone in the facility to wash hands frequently and assist young children with hand washing.
- c. If hand washing is not possible, use hand sanitizer using at least 60% alcohol.
- d. Everyone should practice respiratory etiquette by covering coughs and sneezes.

4. Symptoms of infectious illness

- a. Those with symptoms of infectious illness should stay at home and contact their health provider.
- b. If students arrive at school with symptoms, parents will be contacted, and students will be sent home.

5. Cleaning and disinfection

a. CDC recommends cleaning and disinfecting classrooms and high traffic areas at least once a day.

6. Travel (in state or out of state)

- a. Àny travel outside of your community, KSD recommends COVID testing when returning on the 1st day and 6 days later (can use home tests, clinic tests, or school tests).
 - i. All positive cases will follow recommendations of COVID contact tracers.
- b. Follow the guidelines for your community if they require quarantine or testing.

7. COVID related absences

- a. All KSD students and staff missing school or work, related to COVID, must secure and submit documentation from the contact tracer stating the required time they will be absent.
- b. Any KSD staff with a positive test result must test on the 6th day. If negative, staff will return to work masked until 10th day post- positive (per essential worker recommendations).
