

SUPERINTENDENT'S ADVISORY COUNCIL

The Board of Education believes that input, counsel, and advice from parents is integral to the effective functioning of the educational programs of this district. To this end, the Board directs the Superintendent to establish a Superintendent's Advisory Council to create a forum for parent representatives from each school to share input, concerns, and suggestions on behalf of their school. The Council will also play an integral role in assisting the district in developing various activities and functions designed to educate and inform parents on an array of different education related topics.

The Board of Education President shall also designate one member of the Board of Education who shall serve on this advisory council.
