

**A – VISION 2030: FINANCE & INFRASTRUCTURE****Discussion Item: Committee Report****FINANCE**

19. The Superintendent recommends and so moves the Board of Education of Sayreville to approve the acceptance of a donation of funding to sponsor two staff members from the district to attend the 2018 National Conference on Science in Atlanta, Georgia at an estimated cost of \$2,700.00 from DuPont Electronics & Imaging as part of their commitment to improving science education.

**SUPPORT SERVICES**

20. The Superintendent recommends and so moves the Board of Education of Sayreville to approve the use of ten Board buses on Friday, April 27, 2018 to transport students and chaperones to the Grand Marquis, Old Bridge, NJ for the Sayreville High School Junior Prom. Board buses will be utilized in a four-way move at a cost of \$119.73 (salary \$115.33 – fuel \$4.40) per bus for a total cost of \$1,197.30 to be paid by the Board of Education.

21. The Superintendent recommends and so moves the Board of Education of Sayreville to approve the following trip dates. Fourth grade students and teachers from the Samsel Upper Elementary School will tour the Sayreville Historical Society and visit local landmarks. - a. On Friday, March 2, 2018, thirty Sayreville High School Student Council members and two teachers to Eisenhower Elementary School. Students will participate in Read Across America. One Board bus will be utilized at a cost of \$39.90 (salary \$37.70 – fuel \$2.20) to be paid by the Board of Education.
- b. On Sunday, March 18, 2018, ninety-eight members of the Sayreville High School Marching Band, three teachers and three chaperones to South Amboy, NJ. Students will perform in the St. Patrick's Day Parade. Four Board buses will be utilized at a cost of \$224.62 per bus (salary \$219.12 – fuel \$5.50) for a total cost of \$898.48 to be paid by the Board of Education.
- c. On Friday, April 13, 2018, twenty-four Sayreville High School Choir members and three teachers to Circle in the Square Theatre, New York, NY. Students will see a performance of *Once on This Island*. One Board bus will be utilized at a cost of \$362.33 (salary \$311.38 - fuel \$50.95) to be paid by the SWMHS Choral Parents Association.
- d. On Monday, May 21, 2018, ninety Sayreville Middle School TAG/Student Council members, nine teachers (possibly two chaperones, if needed) to YMCA Camp Bernie, Port Murray, NJ. Students will participate in educational activities with a concentration on teamwork, problem solving and character development. Three Board buses will be utilized to drop off at a cost of \$238.99 (salary \$172.99 – fuel \$66.00) per bus for a total of \$716.97 to be paid by the Board of Education.
- e. On Wednesday, May 23, 2018, three Board buses will be utilized to return students and staff from Camp Bernie to Sayreville Middle School at a total cost of \$716.97 to be paid by the Board of Education.
