DUAL CREDIT:

Dual credit is the term given to courses in which high school students can earn both high school and college credits simultaneously.

- 1. ISD Partnerships & Crosswalks
- 2. Dual credit course offerings and course delivery vary by school.
- 3. Dual credit courses are COLLEGE courses.
- 4. All courses per semester must be approved by a high school counselor.

Requirements

- Students must demonstrate good academic standing.
- Students must meet the Dual Credit Testing Requirements for eligibility. Students must be TSI Complete in Reading & Writing.
- Demonstrate continuous success in dual credit courses.
- Must have High School Counselor's approval of academic performance and all courses taken each semester. (Dual Credit Enrollment Form)
- Must meet all the college's regular prerequisite requirements designated for the courses in which enrolling.


Dual Credit Eligibility

Testing Requirements: Reading and Writing Complete

Students may be eligible to be exempt or have a waiver from the **TSIA2** assessment if they have qualifying scores from:

- STARR End-of-Course
- ASPIRE
- PSAT/NMSQT
- ACT
- SAT
- TSI Assessment



Dual Credit Tuition & Fees

Course	In-District (Navarro County)	Out-of-District (Ellis, Freestone, Limestone, & Leon Counties)
3 Semester Credit Hour Dual Credit Course (Approximately)	\$160.00	\$250.00
4 Semester Credit Hour Dual Credit Course (Approximately)	\$205.00	\$325.00

Lab/Course Fees

* The Dual Credit Rate ONLY applies in the fall and spring academic semesters.

* See catalog/website for all lab/course fees that are in addition to the above amounts.

* Online only courses have an additional \$38 technology fee.

* Immediate access course fees are applied to specific courses for required materials.

What about financial aid?

- Dual Credit Students are not eligible for state or federal financial aid while enrolled in high school.
- Grades earned in dual credit do affect your GPA and FUTURE financial aid eligibility. Our policy requires students to maintain a 2.0 or higher GPA.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: MAY 31, 2022


- Dual Credit Scholarship
- Must be a student at an Ellis County High School.
- Scholarship award is for 1 academic year (Fall & Spring Semesters Only).
- Students must maintain a 3.0 College GPA.
- Books are not covered.

Enrollment

- Enrollment is <u>always</u> coordinated through your high school counselor.
- An admissions application (new students only), parent permission form, current HS transcript, test scores, and shot records must be on file to enroll in courses.
- You must have your high school counselor's approval for all courses each semester.





Deadlines



 ALL enrollment documents must be completed by the deadlines provided by your high school and the NC Dual Credit Department.


