Inform of Survey	Students have completed The California Healthy Kids Survey. Parent surveys will be going home soon, and a Blackboard message will be sent to our parents.
2017/2018 Annual ELD Program Evaluation	Jennifer Johnson shared a presentation of 2017/2018 Annual ELD Program Evaluation. She also explained the new modifications for 2018/2019.
Physical Fitness Report	Emma Pereida-Martinez explained the annual Physical Fitness and reviewed test results which showed growth in a couple of areas. Mrs. Pereida-Martinez attributes it to our 20-minute PE classes and the dedicated elementary PE teachers. She also encouraged parents to continue to enhance health and fitness with their children.
Dashboard Report	Emma Pereida-Martinez shared and gave a brief overview of the Dashboard. She also shared The Five-By-Five Grid which indicates how the district or schools are performing on the state indicators. The performance levels (colors) are from highest to lowest: Blue, Green, Yellow, Orange, and Red. The scores highlight the strengths and areas of opportunity where schools, districts, and state agencies can utilize local control to make decisions on how to continuously improve to ensure students are on track.
ConApp	Emma Pereida-Martinez shared a presentation of Title I, II and III of the Consolidated Application for Funding. This application is used to distribute funds from federal programs to school districts. Each of the major components was included in the review, as well as a breakdown by school site.
Spotlight on District Programs	Attendees enjoyed a presentation which featured all the LCAP action steps that the district has implemented.
