February 22, 2020

Call to Order	Georgia Rhett Patricia Pantoja, DAC Chairperson, called the meeting to order at 9:09 a.m.

Approval of Minutes	Erica Ramirez made a motion to approve the minutes from January 22, 2020 as read. Rocio Castro seconded the motion, and the minutes were approved unanimously. There was no additional discussion nor were there further recommended changes or additions. Motion carried unanimously.
Public Comment	Emma Pereida-Martinez shared the importance of responding to the Census. Responding to the Census helps your community get its fair share of funding. The Migrant and Family Resource center will assist in filling out the questionnaire for those that need assistance.
Security Cameras	Mrs. Pereida-Martinez announced all cameras have been installed at Haven Drive and Sierra Vista. Bear Mountain and El Camino Real to follow. She also addressed a prior request at our last DAC meeting to have an exclusive person monitor cameras. Emma shared with parents that it is against our policy to have an exclusive person monitor the cameras.
State Testing	Emma Pereida-Martinez announced ELPAC testing has begun at all school sites and will continue after Spring Break. She also shared the testing window for CAASPP. A schedule by school site will be shared at our next DAC meeting.
Safety Highlights	Ricardo Salinas, Thomas York, Lupe Calderon and Calletano Gutierrez briefed attendees on the focus on school climate, school safety and strategies at each school site. Topics of mutual interest among schools included monthly drills, evacuation drill, AED and the "I Love you Foundation" Standard Response Protocol. Staff has been trained in all 4 actions (Lockdown, Lockout, Evacuate and Shelter) to respond to an emergency. A parent asked if there was a possibility older students be trained to operate the AED machine. Mrs. Pereida-Martinez suggested Safe School Ambassadors may be trained. She also shared the AED machine provides integrated audio and visual feedback to support you throughout the rescue.
Haven Drive Electives	Mr. Rowatt, Mr. Reyna and Miss Kimbrough shared examples of projects and elaborated on the following electives: <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ AVID➤ Spanish Literature➤ Art Class➤ Science (Engineering)➤ Medical Detectives – made possible through "Project Lead the Way"➤ Band
ConApp	Emma Pereida-Martinez presented a PowerPoint and reviewed Title I, II and III of the Consolidated Application for Funding. This application is used to distribute funds from federal programs to school districts. Each of the major components was included in the review, as well as a breakdown by school site. Gabriela Ojeda made a motion to approve the ConApp. Erika Ramirez seconded the motion and the ConApp was unanimously approved.
LCAP Input	Emma Pereida-Martinez shared that as the LCAP continues to evolve, so does the LCAP template. As part of the LCFF, school districts must develop, adopt, and annually update a three-year plan called the Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP). The LCAP is to be written and developed with feedback and input from community stakeholder groups. Attendees were given the opportunity to provide input on the eight different components of the LCAP.
Reconfiguration	Emma Pereida-Martinez elaborated on the purpose of the Reconfiguration Committee and announced next year there will be modifications to school boundaries to accommodate shifting and expanding populations of students at all three elementary school sites.
Adjournment	Attendees enjoyed the prize drawing. Mrs. Pereida-Martinez thanked everyone for attending the DAC meeting and sharing their ideas and reminded everyone of the upcoming DAC meeting in March. Rocio Castro made a motion to adjourn meeting and Sarah Cabral seconded the motion and the meeting was adjourned at 11:25 am by Patricia Pantoja.
