Facilities-Highlights

- New turf athletic field for high school
- HVAC updates at all schools
- Renovate multi-sport area adjacent to high school stadium
- Prepare for projected increases in enrollment

Technology-Highlights

- Implement 1:1 student devices district-wide
- Plans for management of district software
- Review and update technology infrastructure
- Provide training/professional develop for staff on technology

Finance-Highlights

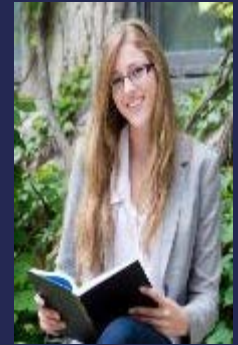
- Increase food service catering revenue
- Secure funding for 1:1 student devices
- Reduce out-of-district contractor costs
- Add funds to reserve accounts annually

Culture & Climate-Highlights

- Increase parent participation/engagement in district
- Reduce number of negative comments/complaints from stakeholders
- Increase staff attendance and reduce grievances by creating a more collaborative environment
- Increase student enfranchisement at all levels

Student Achievement-Highlights

- Improve students' literacy scores district-wide
- Improve students' math scores district-wide
- Improve subgroups student performance district-wide
- Refine district curricula to best meet students' need
