Winter Consolidated Application	Emma Pereida-Martinez reviewed the outlines on the Consolidated Application for Funding. This application is used to distribute funds from various state and federal programs to school districts. With the submission of the Consolidated Application, AUSD is qualified to receive entitlements in Title I, Title II, Title III and Title IV. Mrs. Pereida-Martinez also reviewed each of the major components, as well as funds allocated to each site for school improvement needs. These funds serve as essential resources in the districts efforts to increase student achievement.
Extended Learning Opportunity Plan	Emma Pereida-Martinez gave a brief description of the Extended Learning Opportunity Plan and shared how the district will implement these funds to support our efforts to provide the opportunities necessary for our students as well as supplemental instruction.
